On behalf of the administration at Summit Christian Academy, I would like to petition the Oklahoma State Department of Education to be recognized as a private school that accepts students who qualify to receive the Lindsay Nicole Henry Scholarship for Students with Disabilities. Summit Christian Academy (PO22) is fully accredited by ACTS, ICAA, Advanced ED, and recognized by the Oklahoma State Department of Education.

We service children from Kindergarten through twelfth grades and have an enrollment of approximately 465 students. At this time, we have two students that would like to receive the scholarship warrants.

Beyond our regular course subjects and learning experiences, we have one full time Oklahoma certified teacher with special education endorsements. We also have another teacher, that has several special education college credit hours, who modifies assignments and makes accommodations for students. These teachers work with the classroom teachers to modify and supplement the curriculum for children with special needs. They work with students on an individual basis as well as in small groups. At this time, we are only able to serve students who may be classified as mildly learning disabled.

Summit Christian Academy has a published discipline plan with established procedures for students who violate our code of conduct, and we agree to adhere to these procedures when administering discipline to recipients of the scholarships.

Please accept this letter as a petition to receive scholarship money for students who are enrolled in Summit Christian Academy that qualify for the Lindsay Nicole Henry Scholarship and add our school to the list of private schools who qualify for this program.
