



# Alternative Placement Program

## Secondary and PK-12 Teaching Areas

This document provides the eligibility and program requirements for general **secondary and PK-12 teaching areas**.

This program is **not** for early childhood or elementary education.

### »» Eligibility

To be eligible for the program for general **secondary and/or PK-12 teaching areas**, applicants must meet one of the requirements below (Option A or B). In addition, applicants must not have any failed required teacher education courses.

<b>Option A</b>	
<b>Bachelor’s degree with a retention GPA of 2.50 or higher</b> or <b>Terminal degree (e.g. PhD, EdD, MD, DO, JD, DVM, MFA, MLIS)</b>	Applicants who meet Option A, and are approved, are eligible to seek certification in any general secondary and/or PK-12 area (see eligible areas below).
<b>Option B</b>	
<b>Bachelor’s degree and two years or more of qualified work experience relevant to the area requested</b>	Applicants who meet Option B, and are approved, are eligible to seek certification in the approved area and can later test to add other general secondary/PK-12 areas.

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### »» Process

1. Apply for evaluation
  - a. Submit online application (\$50 fee and upload current resume)
  - b. Send official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended
2. Once approved, pass the appropriate subject area test (as determined by your evaluation)
3. Apply for provisional certificate
  - a. Complete a certification or dual background check (if not currently certified in Oklahoma)
  - b. Submit online application (\$50 fee)
4. Complete program requirements within three years (see next section below)
5. Apply for standard certificate
  - a. Submit online application (\$50 fee)
  - b. Send updated official transcript(s)
  - c. (If applicable) submit a signed district letter verifying professional development

### »» Program Requirements

During Provisional Certification	
<b>Professional Education Assessment</b>	<a href="#">APK</a> – available starting June 3rd, 2025 (formerly the PPAT and OPTE)
<b>Two Professional Education College Courses</b>	Classroom management
	Pedagogical principles (teaching methods)
<b>Professional Development</b>	Hours assigned will vary; 0 to 180 (assigned when the certificate is issued)
