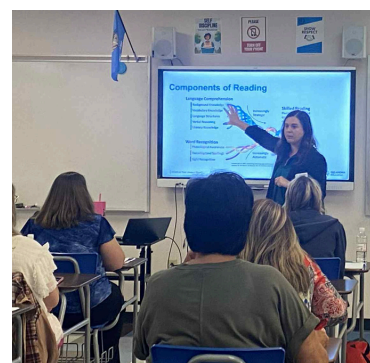


EVENT SUMMARY
