












EVENT SUMMARY

The Guymon Pages Across the Plains Literacy Workshop was a powerful example of regional collaboration, as entire districts—from administrators to paraprofessionals—came together for a full day of hands-on, evidence-based literacy learning. A total of 55 participants, including 6 paraprofessionals, 44 teachers, and 5 school and district leaders, attended the workshop with a shared focus on strengthening literacy instruction. What made this event especially impactful was the way leaders brought their teams with them—learning side by side with their teachers to ensure alignment and momentum back on their campuses. Participants praised the engaging and practical nature of the sessions, especially the writing strategies professional development and the interactive phonological awareness activities, which offered clear takeaways for immediate classroom implementation.
