Dear Oklahoma Turnpike Authority Bondholders:

With mild winter weather during holiday travel periods and in spite of higher fuel prices in the fourth quarter of 2005 over 2004, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) continued to recognize continued, steady revenue growth system-wide for the fourth quarter of 2005. Net toll revenues for the fourth quarter of 2005 surpassed \$48.9 million and realized a strong 3.1% increase over the fourth quarter of 2004. All turnpikes realized revenue growth during 2005, with the six base turnpikes constructed prior to 1990 achieving an overall increase of 2.3% and the four newer turnpikes reaching an impressive 6.1% increase for the fourth quarter of 2005 as compared to 2004. The John Kilpatrick and Creek Turnpikes continue to show consistent growth in the fourth quarter with an increase of net toll revenue of 8.0% and 5.2%, respectively. Toll transactions during the fourth quarter of 2005 surpassed 33.4 million, a significant 4.4% increase over the fourth quarter of 2004. Transaction growth rates in the fourth quarter grew 8.8% on the John Kilpatrick Turnpike and 5.3% on the Creek Turnpike over the same period last year.

While toll revenues were slightly under budget projections for the year, total net revenues for 2005 exceeded budget projections by 3.3%. Revenue fund operating expenses for 2005 were substantially below the annual operating budget by 5.7%. The continued effort by all divisions to monitor costs also contributed to the senior and total debt service ratios continuing to attain budgeted results. Total debt service coverage exceeds minimum trust requirements on a rolling twelve-month basis by approximately 24%.

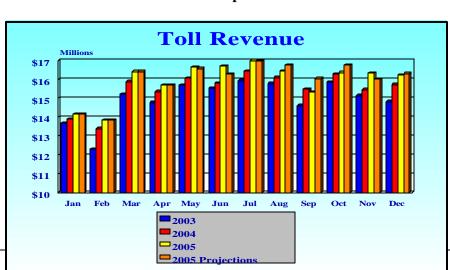
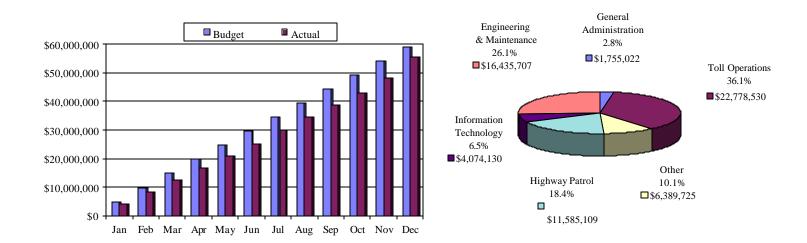


Chart 1: Three-Year Comparison of Toll Revenues

Fourth Quarter Highlights:

- The Authority adopted the calendar year 2006 Annual Budget in November 2005. The 2006 Annual Budget includes a total of \$61,997,642 for the Operating and Maintenance Budget, \$41,777,750 for the Reserve Maintenance Budget, and \$50,391,061 for the General Fund Budget. The amounts budgeted within the Operating and Maintenance Budget increased 4.98% when compared to the 2005 Annual Budget. This increase is due to several factors. A substantial portion of the increase resulted from various State legislation affecting employee benefits such as an increase in the employee benefit allowance for rising insurance premiums, an increase in the employer retirement contribution rate, effective July 1, 2006, and other retirement options for Oklahoma Highway Patrol troopers. In addition, all state employees received a \$700 annual pay increase effective July 1, 2005. The Operating and Maintenance Budget also includes an increase of employees from 594 in 2005 to 606 in 2006. The amounts budgeted within the Reserve Maintenance and General Fund Budgets finance the maintenance, rehabilitation, and improvements included in the 2006 portion of the OTA's five year Capital Plan for the System.
- On December 17, 2005, the *PIKEPASS* Customer Service (*PIKEPASS*), Controller, Information Technology (IT), Finance and Revenue, Internal Audit, and Toll Divisions accomplished the last remaining milestone of the implementation of the new *PIKEPASS* Customer Service Center software application developed by TransCore. A phased implementation program began in mid-2005 and continued as the implementation team worked diligently to identify, test, and resolve issues prior to final cutover to the new system. The culmination of these dedicated efforts was realized in December as all remaining *PIKEPASS* customer accounts were successfully converted to the new customer management software system. The implementation team will continue its efforts to prepare for the Final System Acceptance phase of the project.
- Achieving system maintenance, rehabilitation, and improvements identified in the 2005 portion of the 5-year Capital Improvement Program remains a priority for the OTA. The Sapulpa Toll Plaza project is nearing completion, with construction continuing at the Stroud, Afton, and Vinita Toll Plazas. On the Will Rogers Turnpike, design work has begun on the Walters Toll Plaza reconstruction project. The concrete pavement rehabilitation project encompassing the entire Turner Turnpike is nearing completion. A significant project is underway on the Indian Nation Turnpike to replace all existing signs. In addition, several bridge and pavement rehabilitation projects continue throughout the System.

- During the fourth quarter, the Controller Division assisted the Office of State Finance in the preparation of the State of Oklahoma's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report by providing requested financial information. The Controller Division also began preliminary work for the 2005 audit and preparation of the OTA's 2005 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report. The Controller Division also successfully upgraded its current version of the Platinum accounting software in anticipation of moving to a web-based platform in mid-2006. Debt service transfers were made during December 2005 for the required principal and interest payments due January 1, 2006.
- During November, a member of the Toll Operations Division senior staff attended the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association (IBTTA) operations meeting. The IBTTA is an organization comprised of many representatives from turnpikes, bridges and tunnels around the world. Participation in this organization creates a network for representatives from each respective agency to discuss issues and introduce new ideas for improving operational efficiency. Also in November, several officials from Mexico's Federal Roads and Bridges system met with various members of OTA management staff for a series of discussions to generate ideas that could be incorporated in their country. The Mexican officials also toured different Toll facilities, as well as the *PIKEPASS* Customer Service Center.
- The hazardous effects of the December winter storm weather were minimized for Turnpike customers by maintenance crews plowing and sanding 12,819 lane miles and treating 806 lane miles with magnesium chloride. The total spent on December's inclement weather was approximately \$376,000. In addition, during the fourth quarter the Maintenance Division supervised inmates and utilized contractors in a cost-effective and efficient means of completing asphalt repairs, roadway striping, joint and crack sealing and performing vegetation management.
- Throughout the fourth quarter of 2005, he Toll Operations Division continued several types of employee training developed by the Training Branch. Such training programs include the employee orientation seminar, "Back to Basics" and the "Super Camp" training program. The Training Branch staff also conducted safety seminars for employees at several of the Turnpikes. This contributed to the exemplary job toll collectors did in handling the increased traffic during the holiday season.
- As of December 31, 2005, the total number of active *PIKEPASS* tags increased 10% over the number of 2004 accounts to a total 715,696. Total active *PIKEPASS* accounts totaled 395,647, an increase of 8.0% over the year ending December 31, 2004. *PIKEPASS* patrons continued to take advantage of the *PIKEPASS* volume discount program. Discounts issued to frequent patrons of the System were approximately \$655,171 during the fourth quarter of 2005, a strong 3.2% increase over the fourth quarter of 2004.
