The projects below are weather permitting:

SH-364/Creek Turnpike narrows near E. 101st Tuesday

Eastbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane between E. 193rd onramp and E. 101st off ramp, mm 22, from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday for safety device repairs.

SH-364/Creek Turnpike narrows near Coweta Tuesday, Wednesday

Westbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane between Coweta off-ramp and the New Orleans off-ramp, mile marker 23.65, from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday and again Wednesday for concrete repairs.

SH-364/Creek Turnpike bridge rehabilitation over Haikey Creek underway

Eastbound and westbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane in each direction between S. Gannett Rd. and E. 111th, (mm 14 -15) in Broken Arrow through Friday for continued work on traffic crossovers for a bridge rehabilitation project over Haikey Creek. All ramps are expected to remain open during this project. Motorists should expect delays in through summer 2027

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Heyburn Tuesday

Eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane between Heyburn and Kellyville, mile marker 203- 205, from 2 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday for concrete repairs.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Wellston Monday, Tuesday

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane near Wellston, mile marker 152, from 7 p.m. Monday to 7 a.m. Tuesday for surface repairs. Additionally, westbound lanes will be narrowed at mile marker 152 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday for surface repairs.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike narrows near Eastern Wednesday, Thursday

Eastbound I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will be narrowed near Eastern Ave., mile marker 132-135, from 8 p.m. Wednesday to 6 a.m. Thursday and again from 8 p.m. Thursday to 6 a.m. Friday for streetlight maintenance.

Northbound on-ramp from N.W. 10th to I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike closed Monday, Tuesday

The northbound on-ramp to I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike from N.W. 10th St. will be closed from 7 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday and again from 7 p.m. Tuesday to 6 a.m. Wednesday for surface repairs.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike narrows near N.W. 10th Wednesday, Thursday

Northbound I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane near N.W. 10th St., mm 111-113, from 7 p.m. Wednesday to 6 a.m. Thursday and again from 7 p.m. Thursday to 6 a.m. Friday for surface repairs.



Construction on SH-20 near Claremore could impact I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike exit ramps

A construction project impacting SH-20 in Claremore has left turn lanes at SH-20 reduced to one lane. This may cause some back up onto the exit ramps of I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike. This project is slated to last into spring 2026. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows west of Kellyville through spring 2026

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike lanes are shifted, and the lane width is narrowed with no shoulders between Bristow mm 197 and SH-66 at mm 203 for the widening of the Turner Turnpike to six lanes. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and to watch for heavy equipment entering the work zone.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrowed at SH-99 in Stroud through 2026

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike Lane widths are narrowed between SH-99 (mm 179) in Stroud and the westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza through early 2026 as part of an ongoing widening and realignment of the westbound lanes.

I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud now OPEN

The westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud (mm 179) is now OPEN after a full reconstruction of the overnight truck parking and new facilities for the Love's Travel Stop and McDonald's.

I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike narrows between Adair and Claremore

Westbound and eastbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 260-265 between Adair and Claremore from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. nightly for a resurfacing project through late summer. No ramp closures are expected.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike intermittently narrows to one lane near I-40 and near SH-165 in Muskogee

Westbound SH-341/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane between E. Davis Field Rd. (mm 41) and SH-165/Peak Blvd. (mm 37) in Muskogee for pavement rehabilitation. Additionally, westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane at mm 44-56, near I-40. This is part of a larger capital project that will bring intermittent lane closures along SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike between SH-165 and I-40 from now through fall 2025.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrowed near Muskogee

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in both directions near Muskogee at mm 41 for bridge rehabilitation.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows near Porter through early 2026

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in each direction between SH-51 and E. 181st St. (mm 16-19) near Porter as part of a pavement reconstruction project. Ramps are expected to remain open during this time. Work is expected to continue through early 2026, weather permitting, and will extend from mm

12 just northwest of SH-51 near Coweta to mm 19 at E. 181st St. near Porter. Motorists are advised to expect lane closures in 3-mile segments and to use caution in the area.
