The projects below are weather permitting:

I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike narrows near Adair Tuesday

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane just west of Adair (mm 268) from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Tuesday for barrier wall repairs.

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike narrows near Blanco through Saturday

Southbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane over SH-63 near Blanco (mm 55) from 7 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday and continuing nightly through Saturday for bridge repairs.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows between Luther and Wellston through Saturday

The following locations along the I-44/Turner Turnpike between Luther and Wellston will be narrowed to one lane for ongoing construction survey work:

- Eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike shoulder will be closed between mile markers 148 151 near Luther from 7 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday.
- Eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike shoulders will be closed between mile markers 151 154 near Luther from 7 p.m. Tuesday to 6 a.m. Wednesday and again from 8 p.m. Wednesday to 6 a.m. Thursday.

• Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike shoulder will be closed at mm 155 near Wellston from 7 p.m. Thursday to 6 a.m. Friday and again from 8 p.m. Friday to 6 a.m. Saturday.



Construction on SH-20 near Claremore could impact I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike exit ramps

A construction project impacting SH-20 in Claremore has left turn lanes at SH-20 reduced to one lane. This may cause some back up onto the exit ramps of I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike. This project is slated to last into spring 2026. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area.

SH-364/Creek Turnpike bridge rehabilitation over Haikey Creek underway

Eastbound and westbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane in each direction between S. Gannett Rd. and E. 111th, (mm 14-15) in Broken Arrow for continued work on traffic crossovers for a bridge rehabilitation project over Haikey Creek. All ramps are expected to remain open during this project. Motorists should expect delays in the area through summer 2027.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrowed at SH-99 in Stroud through early 2026

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike Lane widths are narrowed between SH-99 (mm 179) in Stroud and the westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza through early 2026 as part of an ongoing widening and realignment of the westbound lanes.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike intermittently narrows to one lane near I-40 and near SH-165 in Muskogee

Westbound SH-341/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane between E. Davis Field Rd. (mm 41) and SH-165/Peak Blvd. (mm 37) in Muskogee for pavement rehabilitation. Additionally, westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane at mm 44-56, near I-40. This is part of a

larger capital project that will bring intermittent lane closures along SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike between SH-165 and I-40 from now through fall 2025.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows near Porter through early 2026

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in each direction between SH-51 and E. 181st St. (mm 16-19) near Porter as part of a pavement reconstruction project. Ramps are expected to remain open during this time. Work is expected to continue through early 2026, weather permitting, and will extend from mm 12 just northwest of SH-51 near Coweta to mm 19 at E. 181st St. near Porter. Motorists are advised to expect lane closures in 3-mile segments and to use caution in the area.
