The projects below are weather permitting:

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Bristow Tuesday, Wednesday nights

The eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane between mm 198-200 near Bristow from 8 p.m. Tuesday to 6 a.m. Wednesday and again from 8 p.m. Wednesday to 6 a.m. Thursday to shift traffic onto new pavement and to relocate barrier walls in the work zone. This will make more room for continued work in the new median area of the project.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows west of Kellyville through spring 2026

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike lanes are shifted, and the lane width is narrowed with no shoulders between Bristow mm 197 and SH-66 at mm 203 for the widening of the Turner Turnpike to six lanes. Additionally, W. 211th St. is closed between S. 337th W. Ave. and N. 3730 Rd. through summer 2025 for ongoing bridge construction. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and to watch for heavy equipment entering the work zone.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Stroud Wednesday

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at mm 174 between Stroud and Chandler from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Wednesday for surface repairs.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike narrows near N.W. 23rd St. for repairs

The southbound I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at mm 113 just north of N.W. 23rd St. beginning at 9 a.m. Tuesday for emergency repairs to the cable barrier after a collision this past weekend. Lanes will remain narrowed until repairs are complete.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike narrows at N.W. 10th St.; N.W. 23rd St. bridge over turnpike closes Tuesday night through Aug.11

The following closures will take place for bridge repairs on westbound I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike (runs south) at N.W. 23rd St. and at Sara Rd.:

- Westbound I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane between SH-66 and N.W. 10th St. from 8 p.m. Tuesday to 7 a.m. Wednesday and continuing nightly until Monday, August 11 for repairs to the N.W. 23rd St. bridge and the Sara Rd. bridge above the turnpike.
- The N.W. 23rd St. bridge will be closed from 8 p.m. Tuesday through 8 p.m.
 Friday, August 8 while repairs are underway. Local traffic should use the Sara Rd. bridge as a detour during this time.
- The Sara Rd. bridge is expected to close from 8 p.m. Friday, August 8 through 8 p.m. Monday, August 11 for repairs and local traffic should use the N.W. 23rd St. bridge as a detour.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike intermittent lane closures through Tuesday

Eastbound and westbound I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will have intermittent lane closures between Eastern Ave. (mm 136) and I-35 (mm 132) from 8 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday for lane striping. This is part of an ongoing widening project to 6 lanes from Eastern Ave. to I-35.

I-44/Will Rogers narrows near Catoosa Tuesday

Westbound I-44/Will Rogers will be narrowed to one lane at mm 245 between Catoosa and Verdigris from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday for bridge rehabilitation.

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike narrows near Indianola through Aug. 15

The southbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 85-84, 4 miles north of the Ulan/Indianola interchange, through 3 p.m. Friday, Aug. 15, for bridge repairs.

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike narrows near Blanco through Aug. 6

Northbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at mm 58.2 north of Blanco from 2 p.m. Monday through 3 p.m. Wednesday for emergency shoulder repairs.

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike intermittent lanes closures over Mill Creek Tuesday night

Northbound and southbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will have intermittent lane closures on the bridge over Mill Creek (mm 88) at 7 p.m. Tuesday to 6 a.m. Wednesday for bridge striping. Once this work completes, traffic will return to two lanes in each direction.



I-44/Turner Turnpike narrowed at SH-99 in Stroud through 2026

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike Lane widths are narrowed between SH-99 (mm 179) in Stroud and the westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza through 2026 as part of an ongoing widening and realignment of the westbound lanes.

I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud closed through fall 2025

The westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud (mm 179) will temporarily close through fall 2025 to expedite construction of an expansion of overnight truck parking and new facilities for the Love's Travel Stop and McDonald's. Motorists and particularly those in the trucking industry are asked to plan ahead for fuel, food and restroom stops along westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike. Ramps to the communities of Heyburn, Kellyville, Bristow, Stroud, Chandler and Wellston remain open for those needing to access fuel. However, commercial motor vehicle drivers are advised to fuel up ahead of entering westbound Turner Turnpike as truck-accessible fueling stations are limited between Tulsa and Oklahoma City. Commercial trucks should locate alternative overnight parking locations.

I-44/Turner Turnpike lanes shifted at SH-66 in Wellston; SH-66 closed as part of bridge widening project

Westbound and eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike lanes are shifted at SH-66 Wellston (mm 158-157) to a temporary detour for an ongoing bridge reconstruction project

through fall 2025. Ramps will remain open during the lane shift. Motorists are advised to slow down for safety and to remain vigilant in the work zone. Additionally, eastbound and westbound SH-66 remains closed in both directions between the offramps for the I-44/Turner Turnpike (mm 158) in Wellston through fall 2025. This closure is between SH-102 and US-177 in Lincoln County and has a signed detour route.

I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike narrows between Adair and Claremore

Westbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 260-265 between Adair and Claremore from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday-Thursday nights weekly for a resurfacing project through late summer. No ramp closures are expected.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike intermittently narrows to one lane near I-40 and near SH-165 in Muskogee

Westbound SH-341/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane between E. Davis Field Rd. (mm 41) and SH-165/Peak Blvd. (mm 37) in Muskogee through mid-July for pavement rehabilitation. Additionally, westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane at mm 44-56, near I-40. This is part of a larger capital project that will bring intermittent lane closures along SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike between SH-165 and I-40 from now through fall 2025.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrowed near Muskogee

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in both directions near Muskogee at mm 41 for bridge rehabilitation.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows near Porter through early 2026

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in each direction between SH-51 and E. 181st St. (mm 16-19) near Porter as part of a pavement reconstruction project. Ramps are expected to remain open during this time. Work is expected to continue through early 2026, weather permitting, and will extend from mm 12 just northwest of SH-51 near Coweta to mm 19 at E. 181st St. near Porter. Motorists are advised to expect lane closures in 3-mile segments and to use caution in the area.



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
