The projects below are weather permitting:

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike narrows north of Ulan/Indianola interchange through Friday

Southbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at mm 83-84 north of the Ulan/Indianola interchange through 3:30 p.m. Friday, Sept. 26, for bridge joint repairs.

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike narrows north of Daisy interchange through Sept. 29

Northbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at mm 46 about 8 miles north of the SH-43/Daisy interchange from 11 a.m. Tuesday through 10 a.m. Sept. 29 for concrete panel replacement.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows west of Sapulpa Tuesday night

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at mm 216-215 west of Sapulpa from 8 p.m. Tuesday through 6 a.m. Wednesday for concrete repairs.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Luther through Friday

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 136-137 between OKC and Luther from 8 p.m. Thursday to 7 a.m. Friday for concrete repairs



I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows west of Kellyville through spring 2026

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike lanes are shifted, and the lane width is narrowed with no shoulders between Bristow mm 197 and SH-66 at mm 203 for the widening of the Turner Turnpike to six lanes. Additionally, W. 211th St. is now **OPEN** between S. 337th W. Ave. and N. 3730 Rd. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and to watch for heavy equipment entering the work zone.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrowed at SH-99 in Stroud through 2026

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike Lane widths are narrowed between SH-99 (mm 179) in Stroud and the westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza through 2026 as part of an ongoing widening and realignment of the westbound lanes.

I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud closed through fall 2025

The westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud (mm 179) will temporarily close through fall 2025 to expedite construction of an expansion of overnight truck parking and new facilities for the Love's Travel Stop and McDonald's. Motorists and particularly those in the trucking industry are asked to plan ahead for fuel, food and restroom stops along westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike. Ramps to the communities of Heyburn, Kellyville, Bristow, Stroud, Chandler and Wellston remain open for those needing to access fuel. However, commercial motor vehicle drivers are advised to fuel up ahead of entering westbound Turner Turnpike as truck-accessible fueling stations are limited between Tulsa and Oklahoma City. Commercial trucks should locate alternative overnight parking locations.

I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike narrows between Adair and Claremore

Westbound and eastbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 260-265 between Adair and Claremore from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. nightly for a resurfacing project through late summer. No ramp closures are expected.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike intermittently narrows to one lane near I-40 and near SH-165 in Muskogee

Westbound SH-341/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane between E. Davis Field Rd. (mm 41) and SH-165/Peak Blvd. (mm 37) in Muskogee through mid-July for pavement rehabilitation. Additionally, westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane at mm 44-56, near I-40. This is part of a larger capital project that will bring intermittent lane closures along SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike between SH-165 and I-40 from now through fall 2025.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrowed near Muskogee

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in both directions near Muskogee at mm 41 for bridge rehabilitation.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows near Porter through early 2026

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in each direction between SH-51 and E. 181st St. (mm 16-19) near Porter as part of a pavement reconstruction project. Ramps are expected to remain open during this time. Work is expected to continue through early 2026, weather permitting, and will extend from mm 12 just northwest of SH-51 near Coweta to mm 19 at E. 181st St. near Porter. Motorists are advised to expect lane closures in 3-mile segments and to use caution in the area.
