*The projects below are weather permitting:*

**I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Wellston nightly through Saturday**

Eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 158.5 - 163 near Wellston from 7 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday and continuing nightly through 6 a.m. Saturday for geotechnical investigations.

**I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Kellyville Monday, Tuesday nights**

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 209.5 - 208.5 west of Kellyville from 8 p.m. Monday to 8 a.m. Tuesday and again from 8 p.m. Tuesday to 8 a.m. Wednesday for surface repairs.

**I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows west of Wellston Tuesday**

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 150-151.5 between Wellston and Luther from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday for surface repairs. Use caution in the work zone.

**I-44/Turner Turnpike ramp closes at Hogback Rd. Tuesday night**

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike on-ramp from Hogback Rd. (mm 147) will be closed from 8-11 p.m. Tuesday for toll equipment repairs. Use an alternate route during this time.

**I-44/Will Rogers narrows at Verdigris, Catoosa Monday, Tuesday nights**

Westbound and eastbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane in each direction at the Verdigris River Overflow (mm 243-244) and over Mossy Creek (mm 245) between SH-266 near Verdigris and Pine St. near Catoosa from 7 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday and from 7 p.m. Tuesday to 6 a.m. Wednesday for pavement testing.

**SH-364/Creek Turnpike narrows at US-64 interchange Wednesday, Thursday nights**

Eastbound and westbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike will narrow to one lane in each direction between the US-64 interchange and E. 111th St./Florence St. from 8 p.m. Wednesday to 6 a.m. Thursday and again from 8 p.m. Thursday to 6 a.m. Friday to place concrete barrier wall in preparation for a bridge rehabilitation project over Haikey Creek to start in early November.

**SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike ramp closures scheduled at I-40, US-64, SH-165**

The following ramp closures are scheduled on the SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike at US-64, SH-165 and I-40 as part of an ongoing pavement project:

- The eastbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike on-ramp from SH-165 will be closed 7 p.m. Monday to 6 a.m. Tuesday. Detour is westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike to Chandler Rd. to turn south to eastbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike.
- The westbound I-40 ramp to westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike will be closed from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday for surface repairs. Detour is westbound I-40 to the SH-266/US-64 exit to eastbound I-40 to westbound Muskogee Turnpike.

**ONGOING CONSTRUCTION****I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows west of Kellyville through spring 2026**

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike lanes are shifted, and the lane width is narrowed with no shoulders between Bristow mm 197 and SH-66 at mm 203 for the widening of the Turner Turnpike to six lanes. Additionally, W. 211th St. is now **OPEN** between S. 337th W. Ave. and N. 3730 Rd. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area and to watch for heavy equipment entering the work zone.

#### **I-44/Turner Turnpike narrowed at SH-99 in Stroud through 2026**

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike Lane widths are narrowed between SH-99 (mm 179) in Stroud and the westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza through 2026 as part of an ongoing widening and realignment of the westbound lanes.

#### **I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud closed through fall 2025**

The westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike service plaza at Stroud (mm 179) will temporarily close through fall 2025 to expedite construction of an expansion of overnight truck parking and new facilities for the Love's Travel Stop and McDonald's. Motorists and particularly those in the trucking industry are asked to plan ahead for fuel, food and restroom stops along westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike. Ramps to the communities of Heyburn, Kellyville, Bristow, Stroud, Chandler and Wellston remain open for those needing to access fuel. However, commercial motor vehicle drivers are advised to fuel up ahead of entering westbound Turner Turnpike as truck-accessible fueling stations are limited between Tulsa and Oklahoma City. Commercial trucks should locate alternative overnight parking locations.

#### **I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike narrows between Adair and Claremore**

Westbound and eastbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane from mm 260-265 between Adair and Claremore from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. nightly for a resurfacing project through late summer. No ramp closures are expected.

#### **SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike intermittently narrows to one lane near I-40 and near SH-165 in Muskogee**

Westbound SH-341/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane between E. Davis Field Rd. (mm 41) and SH-165/Peak Blvd. (mm 37) in Muskogee through mid-July for pavement rehabilitation. Additionally, westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike (runs north) is intermittently narrowed to one lane at mm 44-56, near I-40. This is part of a larger capital project that will bring intermittent lane closures along SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike between SH-165 and I-40 from now through fall 2025.

#### **SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrowed near Muskogee**

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in both directions near Muskogee at mm 41 for bridge rehabilitation.

### **SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows near Porter through early 2026**

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in each direction between SH-51 and E. 181st St. (mm 16-19) near Porter as part of a pavement reconstruction project. Ramps are expected to remain open during this time. Work is expected to continue through early 2026, weather permitting, and will extend from mm 12 just northwest of SH-51 near Coweta to mm 19 at E. 181st St. near Porter. Motorists are advised to expect lane closures in 3-mile segments and to use caution in the area.
