The projects below are weather permitting:

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows between Heyburn and Kellyville on Tuesday and Wednesday

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed between Heyburn and Kellyville (mm 207-206) from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday for concrete repairs.

Additionally, westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed between the Heyburn and Kellyville interchanges (mm 203 - 211) from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday for concrete repairs.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows near Chandler Tuesday

Westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed near Chandler (mm 169-167) from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday for crack sealing.

I-44/Turner Turnpike narrows between Depew and Bristow, Sapulpa

Eastbound I-44/Turner Turnpike will be narrowed between Depew and Bristow (mm 189 - 197) from 8 p.m. Wednesday through 5 a.m. Thursday and continuing nightly through summer 2026 for asphalt rehabilitation. Additionally, the eastbound W. 96th St./Hilton

Rd. (mm 217A) off-ramp near Sapulpa will be closed from 8 p.m. Wednesday through 5 a.m. Thursday for concrete repairs.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike narrows at S.W. 15th Tuesday

Westbound (runs south) I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane at S.W. 15th Street (mm 109-111) from 8 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday for concrete repairs.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows north of US-62 through Friday

Westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane just north of US-62 (mm 33) near the Hyde Park intersection through 3:30 p.m. Friday, June 12, for concrete repairs. The on-ramp to Hyde Park will remain open.

US-412/Cimarron Turnpike narrows near SH-99 through Friday

Westbound US-412/Cimarron Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane two miles east of SH-99 (mm 52-50) through 2:30 p.m. Friday, June 12, for asphalt repairs to the shoulder.

SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike narrows near Blanco Tuesday

Northbound SH-375/Indian Nation Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane near Blanco (mm 57 - 59) from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday for shoulder work.



I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike intermittent lane shifts through spring 2027

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike will be widened to six lanes between W. Wilshire Blvd. (mm 116) to half a mile north of N.W. 122nd St. (mm 120). Traffic will be shifted, and have a narrowed lane width, but the turnpike will remain open to two lanes in each direction. Northwest and southeast SH-3/N.W. Expressway will be narrowed between County Line Rd. and Morgan Rd. through late spring 2026 for bridge work above the highway.

I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike narrows at Council Rd. through summer 2026

The following lane closures will impact traffic on the I-344/John Kilpatrick Turnpike at Council Rd.:

- Eastbound John Kilpatrick Turnpike will have narrowed lane widths, and the lanes will slightly shift at Council Rd. through summer 2026.
- Eastbound Memorial Rd. will be narrowed to one lane between Council Rd. and Rockwell Ave. through summer 2026 for construction of the new lane and the new on-ramp to John Kilpatrick Turnpike.
- Northbound and southbound Council Rd. lanes will be narrowed and shifted between just north of westbound Memorial Rd. and just south of eastbound Memorial Rd. through summer 2026 for the construction of protected turnaround lanes.

I-44/Turner Turnpike bridge reconstruction at Arcadia Lake

I-44/Turner Turnpike bridge reconstruction at mm 136 between I-35 and Midwest Boulevard will replace the existing twin bridges with a single bridge built for the turnpike's future six lanes. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be open during construction, but motorists can expect lane shifts throughout the project through spring 2027.

I-44/Turner Turnpike shoulder closed west of Wellston at mm 154 through summer 2026

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Turner Turnpike shoulders are closed on the bridge over County Rd. NS3310 about 1 mile west of SH-102 in Lincoln County as part of a bridge widening project. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area while construction is ongoing.

US-312/Cimarron Turnpike Spur narrowed for bridge rehab through fall 2026

This project rehabilitates the US-312/Cimarron Turnpike Spur bridge over US-177 (mm 19-20) near Stillwater. Motorists are reminded to stay alert in the work zone and to expect shifted lanes through fall 2026.

I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike narrows near Claremore through winter 2026

Eastbound and westbound I-44/Will Rogers Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane near Claremore (mm 255-260) from 7 p.m. Monday to 7 a.m. Tuesday and continuing nightly through Friday for a pavement resurfacing project. This work will extend between mm 32 near the Creek Turnpike to mm 260 on the Will Rogers through winter 2026.

SH-364/Creek Turnpike narrows at US-64 in Broken Arrow over Haikey Creek; eastbound ramp from 96th St. closed

Westbound and eastbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike are narrowed to one lane in each direction between US-64 and E. 111th St. (mm 14-15) in Broken Arrow through summer 2027 as part of the Haiky Creek bridge rehabilitation project. The eastbound SH-364/Creek Turnpike on-ramp from 96th St. is closed through fall 2026 to safely facilitate construction. Motorists should expect delays in the area through summer 2027.

SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike narrows near Porter through summer 2026

Eastbound and westbound SH-351/Muskogee Turnpike is narrowed to one lane in each direction between just northwest of SH-51 and E. 181st St. (mm 12-19) near Porter as part of a pavement reconstruction project. Ramps are expected to remain open during this time. Motorists are advised to expect lane closures in 3-mile segments and to use caution in the area.

I-44/H.E. Bailey Turnpike narrows between Randlett, Walters and at Geronimo through late summer for pavement reconstruction

Westbound I-44/H.E. Bailey Turnpike (runs south) will be narrowed to one lane between US-277/SH-5 (mm 20) at Walters and E1870 Rd. through spring for pavement reconstruction. Eastbound I-44/H.E. Bailey Turnpike (runs north) is narrowed to one lane between US-277/US-70 (mm 5) at Randlett to 3 miles north of the interchange at mm 8 through spring.

This work is part of a larger project that will address pavement conditions between US-277/US-70 (mm 5) at Randlett and US-277/SH-5 (mm 20) at Walters through late summer 2026. Additionally, H.E. Bailey Turnpike will be narrowed to one lane between SH-36/S.W. Baseline Rd. (mm 30) at Geronimo to SW Burk Rd./E1740 Rd. (mm 29) with intermittent ramp closures at SH-36 later in the project.



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
