Previous Change:

BUILDING DRAIN. That part of the lowest piping of a drainage system that receives the discharge from soil, waste, and other drainage pipes inside and that extends 30 inches (752 mm) <u>5 feet</u> (<u>1524 mm</u>) in developed length of pipe beyond the exterior walls of the building and conveys the drainage to the building sewer.

(1) Combined. A building drain that conveys both sewage and storm water or other drainage.

(2) Sanitary. A building drain that conveys sewage only.

(3) Storm. A building drain that conveys storm water or other drainage, but not sewage.

Historical information

This change was made by the 2015 FGMP committee to better align with the industry convention that the site sewer (civil) picks up at 5 feet outside of the building. The 2021 edition lists the same definition as the 2018 without the OUBCC modification.
