3313.2 When combustible building materials of the building under construction are delivered to a site, a minimum fire flow of 500 gallons per minute (1893 L/m) shall be provided. The fire hydrant used to provide this fire flow supply shall be within 500 feet (152 m) of the combustible building materials, as measured along an approved fire apparatus access lane. Where the site configuration is such that one fire hydrant cannot be located within 500 feet (152 m) of all combustible building materials, additional fire hydrants shall be required to provide coverage in accordance with this section.

Exception: The fire code official is authorized to reduce the fire flow requirements or provide other water supply alternatives in rural areas or small communities where the development of full fire-flow requirements is impractical.

Supporting Information:

A very large portion of the State of Oklahoma is comprised of rural areas that are not served by an established water system. In those areas, the AHJ should be allowed to approve alternatives to satisfy fire protection requirements during construction.
