## Proposed Change:

Section 423.5 is amended to read as follows:

Section 423.5 Group E Occupancies. In areas where the shelter design wind speed for tornadoes is 250 MPH in accordance with Figure 304.2(1) of ICC 500, all <u>new buildings or structures</u>, or changes in occupancy group, incorporating Group E occupancies with an occupant load of 50 or more shall have a storm shelter constructed in accordance with ICC 500.

#### **Exception:**

- 1. Group E day care facilities.
- 2. Group E occupancies <u>used in conjunction with religious activities</u> and accessory to places of religious worship.
- 3. Buildings meeting the requirements for shelter design in ICC 500.

4. Additions to Group E occupancies shall comply with the requirements of Section 303 of the International Existing Building Code.

## Supporting Information:

State the purpose and reason for the change and provide substantiation to support the proposed change.

The purpose for this change is to guarantee that structures newly converted to E-use will also be included as requiring a storm shelter. The amendment to exception 2 provides that schools using church facilities will not be granted such exception as they are not truly accessory to the religious use. (We have seen a number of private schools utilize church structures in such cases.) The addition of exception 4 is to guarantee that schools adding new occupancy load must also provide shelters for said occupants.
