## Which area of the code (Section, Table, Figure) was be revised?

#### **Previous change:**

**2308.3.2** Warning signs. Warning signs complying with Section 310 shall be posted as follows: (A) Warning sign(s) shall be conspicuously posted within sight of each dispenser in the fuel dispensing area and shall state the following: (i) No smoking (ii) Shut off motor (iii) Flammable Gas (iv) Natural gas vehicle fuel cylinders shall be inspected at intervals not exceeding 3 years or 36,000 miles to ensure safe operation of the vehicle (v) Natural gas fuel cylinders past their end-of-life date shall not be refueled and shall be removed from service. (B) A warning sign with the words "No smoking, flammable gas" shall be posted in all compressor and storage areas. (C) The lettering on the sign shall be legible and large enough to be visible from each point of transfer. (D) The service pressure of each dispenser shall be posted in view of the operator.

#### Historical information:

The modification was added by the AFPTC to bring the language required in NFPA 52 into the IFC for warning signage for CNG fuel. The language is not in the 2021 code. Staff recommendation is to keep it in the agency's rules.
