General Project Description:

Wilburton Public Works Authority (Authority), located in Latimer County, has a population of 2,285 (United States Census 2020). As of 2025, it services 1,031 active water connections and 972 sewer connections.

The Authority owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) where the current process comprises bar screens, comminutors, grit chambers, flow equalization, stormwater holding pond, two final clarifiers, two aeration tanks, land application, sludge thickeners, anaerobic digestors, and chlorination/dechlorination. The present average daily flow is 0.75 million gallons per day (MGD). Much of the equipment is in poor and deteriorating condition that results in system failures during rain events and needs to be replaced. This project is to replace and repair vital equipment including blowers, alum pumps, bar screens, variable frequency drives, SCADA, transfer switches, generators, control panels, and other various pumps at the existing wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) and lift stations. The estimated cost is \$1,582,700 which will be fully funded through a Clean Water SRF Loan.
