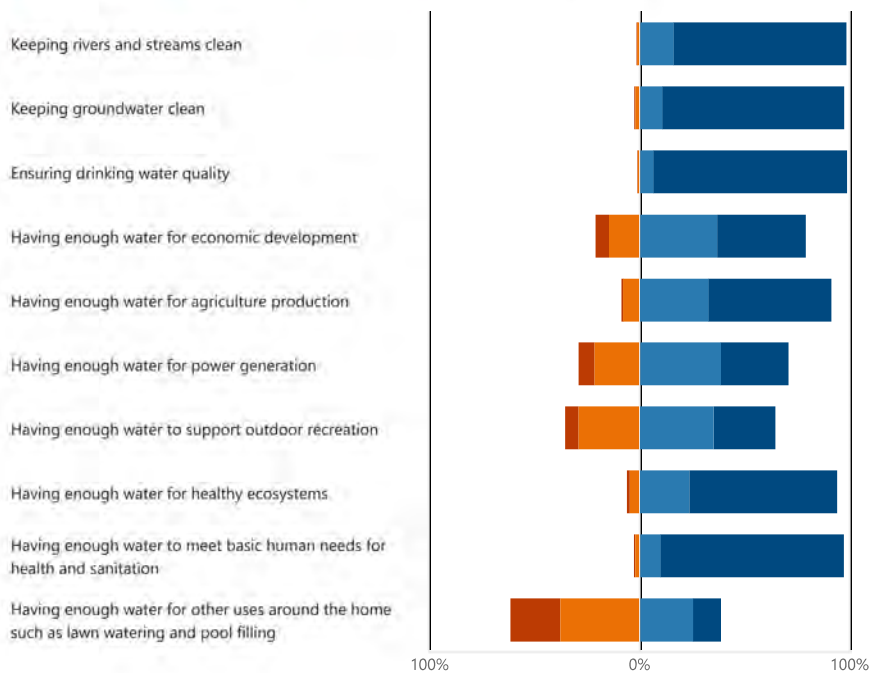

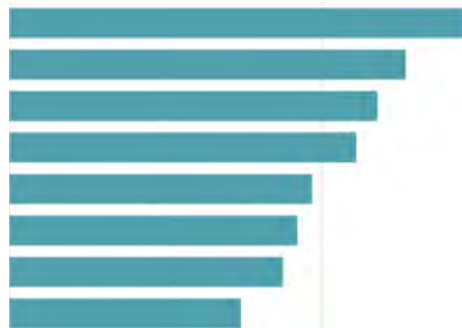

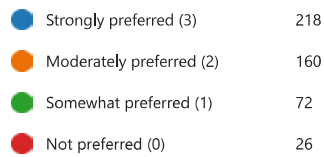
12. Artificial aquifer recharge and recover.

Injecting water directly into an aquifer, or recharge through spreading basins, where the water is stored for later use.



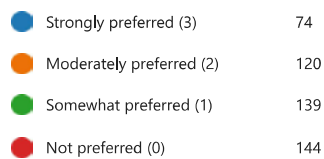
13. Stormwater capture and use.

Collection, storage, and treatment of urban stormwater runoff for a designated beneficial freshwater purpose, such as drinking water, irrigation, or industrial uses.



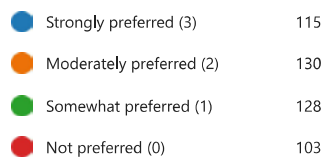
14. Transferring water from one basin to another.

Transferring water through pipelines from a source in an area with available supplies to another area with limited supplies.



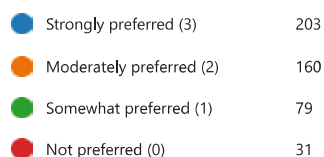
15. Developing new surface water lakes/reservoirs.

Construction of a new surface water lake/reservoir.

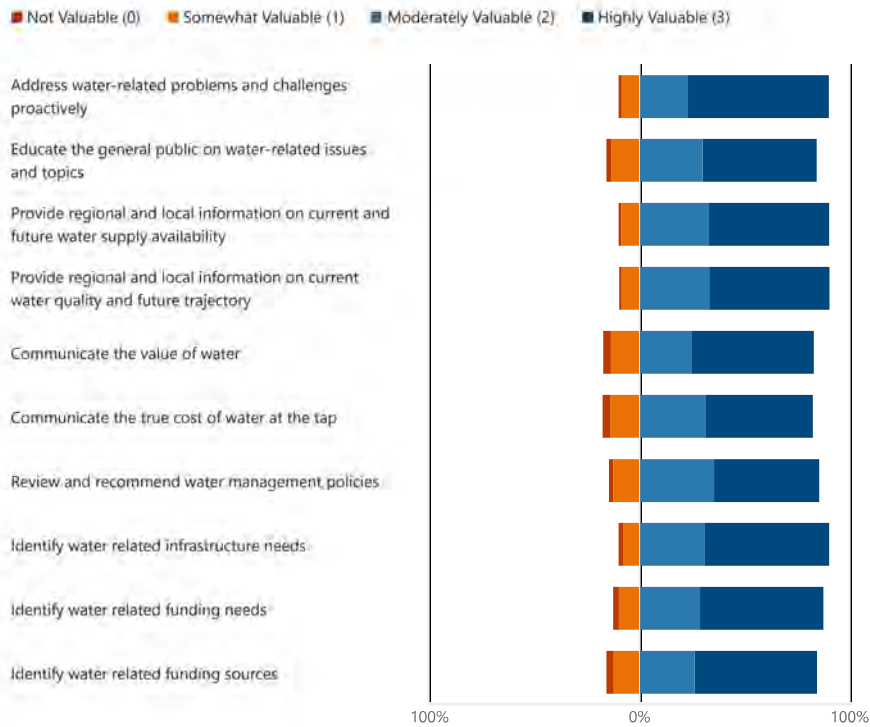


16. Maximizing water supplies in existing lakes/reservoirs.

Convey, treat, or allocate available water from an existing surface water lake/reservoir.

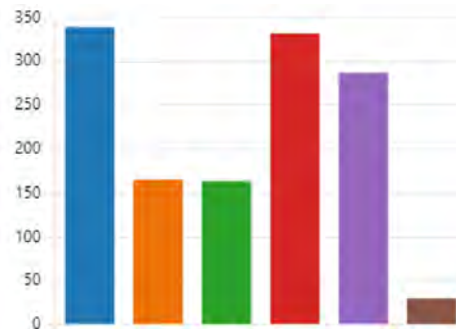


17. In what areas can the Oklahoma Comprehensive Water Plan provide the most value? Please score the options.



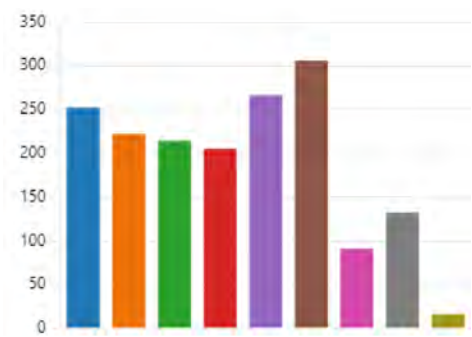
