MRA Ceremony Signing (previously published in NCEES Licensure Exchange)

Earlier this year, a mutual recognition agreement (MRA) between the United States and the United Kingdom was finalized and approved by NCEES and the UK Engineering Council (ECUK).

This agreement aims to provide a more direct path for licensed engineers to practice in each country and was built on the framework of the International Professional Engineers Agreement, of which both countries are members. The MRS acknowledges and upholds discipline-specific and jurisdictional requirements of the member boards that decide to participate.

At the August 2024 Annual NCEES Meeting in Chicago, the Oklahoma State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Surveyor signed the MRA referenced above with the Engineers Council UK. The Board is in the process of developing Administrative Rules to implement this agreement.

Most Frequent Violations of the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Surveying

Whether you have been licensed as a professional surveyor for 5 years or 50 years, it's a good practice to take a few minutes and review the most current requirements as described in the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Surveying.

The standards summarized below describe issues commonly observed by the Board while reviewing surveys which are not in compliance with the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Surveying.

Disagreements with Another Surveyor 245:15-13-2(b)

If a surveyor discovers a material disagreement with another surveyor's work, they should make reasonable efforts to contact and resolve the disagreement.

Site Visit Dates and Revisions 245:15-13-2(c)(4)

Survey documents must include the date of the last site visit and any revisions. If the site visit occurred on multiple dates, the range of dates may be specified.

Symbols/Abbreviations 245:15-13-2(c)(6)

Any symbols or abbreviations used to represent physical objects must be clearly explained on the drawing.

Monument Details 245:15-13-2(c)(12)

The type and size of all monuments (either found or set) and the relationship to surveyed lines and corners must be shown on the drawing.

Survey Control 245:15-13-2(c)(7)(A)

The basis of control used in the survey must be clearly shown and shall include reference to specific zones (e.g., North or South Zone of Oklahoma State Plane).

Public Land Survey System 245:15-13-2(c)(8)(A)

Surveys based on the United States Public Land Survey System shall be referenced to original or properly restored corners.

Inconsistencies in Survey 245:15-13-2(9)

If inconsistencies like overlapping descriptions or conflicting boundaries are found, they must be clearly shown on the drawing.

Legal Description 245:15-13-2(15)

Every survey plat must contain the legal description of the land being surveyed, either on the face of the plat or referenced as an attachment.

April 2024

Hall Engineering Group, LTD CA 7587 and Justin Hall PE 27542, Case 2023-081

Through Consent: Hall Engineering Group LTD and Justin Hall failed to comply with the terms imposed and agreed to in Board Case No. 2021-059. Further, Hall failed to meet the requirements for maintaining direct control of engineering reports prepared by Henry Martin, EI. In this regard Hall Engineering Group and Justin Hall were found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$3,500.

MPK Structural Engineering LLC CA 9331 and Pavan Sundaresh Manepalli TL 968, Case 2024-005

Through Consent: MPK Structural Engineering LLC and Manepalli did not have a Certificate of Authorization or a Professional Engineer license, respectively, in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or perform engineering services at the time it offered and/or performed engineering services in the State of Oklahoma. In this regard MPK Structural Engineering LLC and Pavan Sundaresh Manepalli were found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$2,400.

American Roofing and Construction, LLC and Jeff Beets, Case 2024-011

Through Consent: American Roofing and Construction, LLC and Jeff Beets did not have a Certificate of Authorization or a Professional Engineer license, respectively, in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or perform engineering services. In this regard American Roofing and Construction, LLC and Jeff Beets were found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$1,700 and ordered to Cease and Desist from practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in the State of Oklahoma until such time as they are legally authorized.

June 2024

Atwell, LLC CA 5387 and Carey P. Lege PLS 1899, Case 2023-075

Through Consent: Atwell, LLC did not have a Certificate of Authorization in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or practice land surveying at the time it offered and performed surveying services on multiple projects in the State of Oklahoma. Further the firm's title block was on multiple surveys in which Lege performed surveying services that did not meet the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Surveying and filed corners which were inaccurate. Atwell, LLC was found Guilty and assessed an administrative penalty of \$5,500. Carey P. Lege was found Guilty of aiding and assisting Atwell, LLC, in violating the Corner Perpetuation and Filing Act and failing to meet minimum standards as required by the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Land Surveying. Further, by failing to file accurate and timely Certified Corner Records, and failing to maintain direct control and exercise sufficient personal supervision of the work, Carey P. Lege was found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$6,000.

Jerme Bowers PE 29467, Case 2023-123

Through Consent: Jerme Bowers was found Guilty of offering and/or performing engineering services outside his approved area of competency. In this regard Jerme Bowers was found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$4,000.

Allegro Civil Engineers, P.C. CA 9372 and Austin J. Hahn PE 29678, Case 2024-037

Through Consent: Allegro Civil Engineers, P.C. did not have a Certificate of Authorization in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or practice engineering services on a project in Oklahoma. Austin J. Hahn aided and assisted Allegro in offering to practice and/or practicing engineering in the State of Oklahoma. In this regard Allegro Civil Engineers, P.C. and Austin J. Hahn were found Guilty, Reprimanded and assessed an administrative fine of \$3,000.

September 2024

Sandlin Surveying, PC CA1281 and Bryan Sandlin, PS 1483, Case 2024-005

Through Consent: Sandlin Surveying, P.C. and Bryan Sandlin did not have an active Certificate of Authorization or an active Professional Land Surveyors license, respectively, in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or practice surveying. In this regard Sandlin Surveying and Bryan Sandlin were found guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$10,000.

Aric Glasser PE 23175, Case 2024-043

Through Consent: Aric Glasser failed to comply with the Continuing Education Audit for the renewal period of March 1, 2022 to February 29, 2024 and provided false information to the Board when renewing his Professional Engineer license. In this regard Aric Glasser was found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$1,500, and his license was suspended until such time as his continuing education requirements were met.

True North Engineering and E.H. "Gene" Robertson, Case 2024-057

Through Consent: True North Engineering and E.H. "Gene" Robertson did not have a Certificate of Authorization or Professional Engineering license, respectively, in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or practice engineering services for a project in the State of Oklahoma. In this regard True North Engineering and E.H. "Gene" Robertson were found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$3,600, and ordered to Cease and Desist from practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in the State of Oklahoma until such time as they are legally authorized.

Sal Fateen PE 18023, Case 2024-089

Through Consent: Sal Fateen failed to comply with the Continuing Education Audit for the renewal period of February 1, 2022 to January 31, 2024 and provided false information to the Board when renewing his Professional Engineering license. In this regard Sal Fateen was found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$1,500, and his license was suspended until such time as his continuing education requirements were met.

November 2024

Chappell Land Surveying CA 5072 and T.D. Chappell PE 1673, Case 2023-050

Through Consent: Chappell Land Surveying and T.D. Chappell failed to achieve minimum standards as required by the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Land Surveying on multiple projects in the State of Oklahoma, and exhibited habitual failure to discharge its duties, obligations, and responsibilities as a professional land surveyor and firm. Further, T.D. Chappell failed to file Certified Corner Records, violating the Corner Perpetuation and Filing Act. T. D. Chappell and Chappell Land Surveying failed to comply with all requirements of probation as described in the Consent Order in Case No. 2012-009. In this regard Chappell Land Surveying was found Guilty, Reprimanded, and assessed an administrative fine of \$5,000. T.D. Chappell was found Guilty, Reprimanded, placed on Probation, ordered to complete a surveying ethics course as specified, and assessed an administrative fine of \$12,000.

November 2024 (continued)

Total Design Engineering LLC CA 9481 and Stephen Clanton PE 355346, Case 2024-003

Through Consent: Total Design Engineering LLC and Stephen Clanton did not have a Certificate of Authorization or Professional Engineering license in the State of Oklahoma to offer and/or practice engineering services for the Oklahoma City, OK project. In this regard Total Design Engineering LLC and Stephen Clanton were found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$1,500 each.

Jackson & Jackson Engineering, Inc. CA 3770 and John D. Jackson PE 18301, Case No. 2024-044

Through Consent: Jackson & Jackson Engineering, Inc. and John D. Jackson did not have a Certificate of Authorization or a Professional Land Surveying license, respectively, in the State of Oklahoma to offer/or practice land surveying services for an Oklahoma project. In this regard Jackson & Jackson Engineering, Inc. and John D. Jackson were found Guilty, assessed an administrative fine of \$1,400 each, and ordered to Cease and Desist from practicing and/or offering to practice land surveying in the State of Oklahoma.

Kevin Shertz, Case No. 2024-046

Through Consent: Kevin Shertz failed to submit a complete permanent professional engineering application to the Board within the thirty days of the date of issuance of the temporary license. In this regard Kevin Shertz was found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$2,000.

GeoEngineers, Inc. CA 6260, Case No. 2024-091

Through Consent: GeoEngineers, Inc. did not have an active Certificate of Authorization in the State of Oklahoma at the time it offered to perform and/or performed engineering services project for an Oklahoma project. In this regard GeoEngineers, Inc. was found Guilty and assessed an administrative fine of \$3,000.

Interested in Retiring Your P.E. or P.S. License?

OAR: 245:15-7-1(c) states, "When a professional engineer or land surveyor in good standing desires to retire his or her license, he or she may do so upon application to the Board, subject to reinstatement and continuing education requirements by the Board." If retirement is the reason for not renewing your license and you choose to place your license on Retired status, you may do so from the online renewal site. Register and log in to your online renewal account, select "Renew", then choose the retirement option when prompted and complete the process online. By choosing the Retired status, you will no longer be required to earn continuing education hours or be required to pay a fee. However, you will not be allowed to practice your profession in Oklahoma. You will receive a wallet card showing Retired status and you will remain on the Board's online roster as Retired. PLEASE NOTE: If you renew your license and certify that you have met the continuing education requirements, you shall NOT be allowed to retire your license after the fact in lieu of an administrative action if you are chosen for audit and do not have the required hours.
