## MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR



**Glen W. Smith, PE, PLS - Board Chair**

I am looking forward to the upcoming year as an opportunity to serve the Board as its Chair. As both a licensed professional engineer and surveyor, I feel fortunate to have a broad perspective of the regulatory issues that face both professions. This is the beginning of my sixth year on the Board, and I am continually amazed at the wide range and complexity of the issues that come before the Board.

As a delegate at the NCEES annual meeting held in St. Louis, Missouri in August, I participated in several days of national discussions regarding many of the same issues we face locally - issues such as licensure mobility, enforcement, computer-based testing, national examination development, and proposed changes to the laws and rules.

Notably, during the upcoming year, because Oklahoma's law was amended in the 2011-2012 legislative session, extensive rule changes will be considered in 2012 and 2013 to support these changes. The statutory revisions are available on the Board's website and were effective August 24, 2012. The legislative process seems to be a tedious and continuous process at the Board, but a very necessary one. Changes in technology and the professions in general require that regulations be looked at regularly to ensure that they are still relevant and doing what they are intended to do - which is to safeguard life, health and property, and

to promote the public welfare. They are not written to protect the professions of engineering and surveying, but they are also not intended to impede the professions needlessly. Sometimes that distinction is a fine line and the Board works diligently to find that proper balance.

Also during the next year, national changes are being made to the NCEES examinations with regard to Software Engineering and computer based testing. These changes have been worked on by specific committees within NCEES, on which many of our Oklahoma board members and staff play an important role. Oklahoma continues to provide leadership and expertise to NCEES at the southern zone and national levels, which is important not only for the Oklahoma board itself, but for the professionals it licenses and the citizens of the state of Oklahoma.

I see this year as Chair as an opportunity for me to continue to learn and grow personally and professionally from my involvement with the Board and NCEES, and to use my experience from the past five years as a Board Member to lead the Board and staff in a productive and decisive direction. If you have input, comments or suggestions you can submit those at any time to the Board office or to me directly.

## OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY RECEIVES 2012 NCEES ENGINEERING AWARD

Oklahoma State University's School of Civil and Environmental Engineering's entry, Roadway and Water Feature Design at the Botanic Garden, was selected as one of five winners to receive a \$7,500 award from the 2012 NCEES Engineering Award. Florida Atlantic University's Department of Civil, Environmental, and Geomatics Engineering was the \$25,000 grand prize winner for its submission.

Each year, the NCEES Engineering Award invites EAC/ABET-accredited programs from all engineering disciplines to submit projects that integrate professional practice and education. The winners are selected by a jury of NCEES members and representatives from academic institutions and professional engineering organizations. "We're excited to see such innovative approaches to teaching students about professional practice," said NCEES President Dale Jans, P.E. "Emphasizing the importance of technical competency and ethical practice is critical to educating the next general of professional engineers; we hope this award will inspire other colleges to introduce similar collaborations."

OSU's winning entry involved professors, students, and engineering consultants. The project, as described by Dr. John Veenstra, involved the students designing a roadway inside the OSU Botanic Garden that led from the south entrance into the garden and eventually terminated at a parking lot. One of the unique challenges with the road location was that it was inside a wetland. The Botanic Garden has a general mission of environmental sustainability. As such, the roadway the students were tasked with designing was to incorporate various types of environmentally friendly materials.



Professors, consultants and students involved in the project all seemed to gain from the experience, as described in the following quotes:

**Dr. Dale Maronek, Professor and Head of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture and Director of the Botanic Garden at OSU:**

*This has been a very rewarding project in many different ways. The Civil Engineering students were extremely creative and generated a lot of great ideas that will help shape the further development of our environmental road system at the Botanic Garden. I think the project really challenged the students to think outside the box. Dr. Veenstra did a great job involving industry professionals in the project. The professionals challenged the students and were able to highlight many real world issues and practices....I have been involved in many interdisciplinary projects, but this is one of the most enjoyable and rewarding. It is great to work with people willing to collaborate and explore new ideas.*

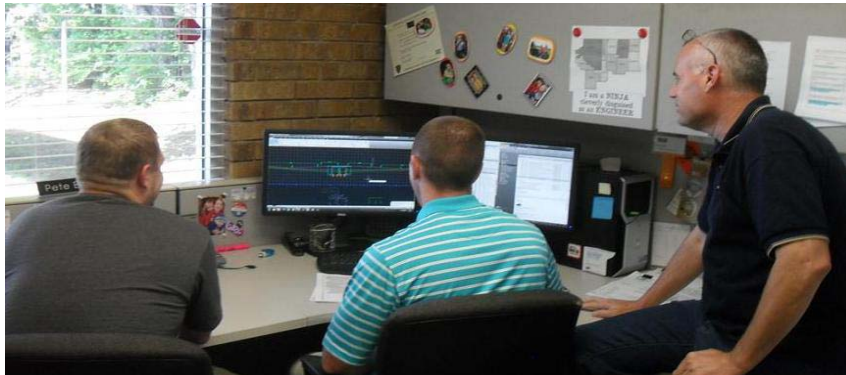

### McVey named into Academy of Electrical Engineering by the University of Arkansas

**B**oard Member William “Bill” A. McVey, Jr., PE, was inducted into the University of Arkansas Academy of Electrical Engineering, at their annual banquet held on April 20, 2012. Mr. McVey was a 1971 graduate of the University of Arkansas, which had a graduating class of 25 students. Today the university has over 200 undergraduate students majoring in electrical engineering and over 70 graduate electrical engineering students each year.

Mr. McVey began his career at Oklahoma Gas and Electric company from 1971 – 1979. During that time he was also an evening professor at several Oklahoma universities. From 1979 – 1984, he was the Chief Electrical Engineer for Frankfurt-Short-Bruza. Since 1984, Mr. McVey has been with PSA Consulting Engineers, Inc. in Oklahoma City. He has served as President since 1993.

Appointed to the Board in 2002 by Governor Frank Keating, Mr. McVey is serving his second six-year term and continues to be active in state and national issues regarding engineering and surveying licensure.



### Pitts Named *David Page Distinguished Service Award* Recipient by the Oklahoma Society of Land Surveyors



**O**klahoma Emeritus Board Member and current Director of Enforcement, Bruce Pitts, PLS, was named the recipient of the David Page Distinguished Service Award by the Oklahoma Society of Land Surveyors at its March, 2012 annual convention. The award is presented annually to a person who exemplifies service to the Society and to the profession of land surveying.

Bruce A. Pitts, PLS, is a licensed land surveyor in Oklahoma and in 1976 began practicing land surveying and land subdivision design with emphasis on land title surveys and boundary analysis and boundary dispute resolution. He received his B.S. degree in Engineering Technology from Oklahoma State University. He was on the land surveying faculty of OSU-OKC for over 30 years. Mr. Pitts is a past president of the Oklahoma Society of Land Surveyors, and an Associate Member of the Oklahoma Land Title Association. He was also the recipient of the 2000 NCEES Distinguished Service Award.

## PLS EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

### URGENT INFORMATION FOR FUTURE PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR APPLICANTS

***PLEASE PASS ALONG THIS INFORMATION TO ANYONE YOU KNOW WHO MAY BE  
CONSIDERING APPLYING FOR LICENSURE AS A PLS***

- April 2014 is the last date to take the PS and/or OLS if admitted under Long Established Practice - LEP. This requirement allows applicants to apply with 9 years of qualifying, progressive experience approved by the Board.
- If the applicant has not met all of the requirements for licensure by July 2014 and wishes to continue the path to licensure, they will be required to reapply with proof of meeting the educational requirements established by the Board, along with qualifying experience.

- Even if you have qualified for the exams by LEP, you are encouraged to start taking land surveying classes now. Much of the surveying exams are based on knowledge obtained in college level surveying class work. Taking college classes in the Core Curriculum will improve an applicant's chance of success on the examinations and improve the chance of success in their surveying practice. Further, a LEP applicant who does not complete all of the examinations prior to the April 2014 exam administration will be that much closer to qualifying for licensure by an education pathway.

# THE PATH TO COMPLIANCE

## BOARD BENEFITS FROM THE NCEES LAW ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

An important function of the National Council of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors (NCEES) is to assist its member boards in their statutory responsibility of administering their respective laws pertaining to the regulation of the engineering and surveying professions. Member boards are the 69 separate licensing entities throughout the United States, Guam, the Mariana Islands and Puerto Rico. The mission of all member boards is basically the same - to safeguard the life, health, property, and to promote the public welfare of the citizens they serve by administering the respective laws efficiently, fairly, and judiciously. Regulation of these professions consists of two important functions:

1. *Licensure* to ensure that professional engineer and surveyor applicants are qualified to practice their profession in their respective states
2. *Enforcement* to ensure that licensees are performing their professional services in conformity with the intent and purpose of the law and related rules of professional conduct and to protect the public from the unlicensed practitioner

One way NCEES serves its member boards is to present a comprehensive law enforcement program at its annual meeting held each year in August. At the NCEES annual meeting just concluded, a full day and a half was dedicated to Law Enforcement activities. The Law Enforcement Forum was held one afternoon, followed by the Law Enforcement Program which was an all day training and educational event the following day.

The Law Enforcement Forum was a roundtable discussion of issues chosen by attendees and spearheaded by a panel of enforcement officials which this year included Mark Caruthers,



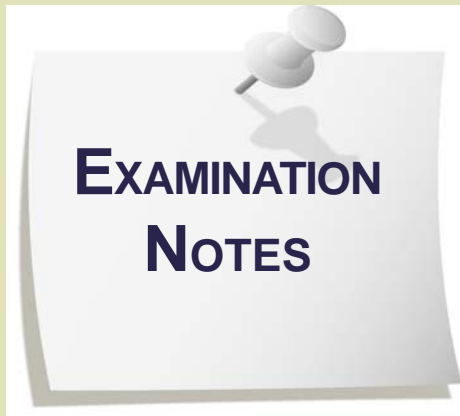

one of our own Board Investigators. The interchange of ideas between over 75 enforcement officials, attorneys and board members from all across the nation provided each of us with new perspectives on issues that affect us all. Some of the current and relevant topics discussed were:

- The definition of responsible charge (direct supervisory control)
- What exactly is “public health, safety and welfare?”
- Recent legal actions that impact regulatory agencies
- Exam Collusion (cheating) investigations
- Use of Social Media as evidence during Investigations
- Board initiated complaints, such as those coming from continuing education audits, placing false information on applications, or investigating projects that were bid or commenced prior to licensure
- Exemption from state licensure for Federal projects (supremacy law)
- Expanded use of the NCEES Enforcement Exchange (the nation wide data base where violations in each state are posted)

Sharing information on how other states handle these topics helps all of us find consensus on the best practices for effective investigations. As a result of attending this Forum, some board members and staff present learn about the NCEES

### **PS Exam - closed-book in April 2013**

The NCEES Principles and Practice of Surveying (PS) exam will become a closed-book exam in April 2013. At that time, examinees will use NCEES-supplied references during the exam and will no longer be allowed to bring other reference material into the exam room. The exam is becoming an closed-book exam for exam security purposes and to facilitate the transition to a computer based examination in the future.

### **FE/FS to be administered using CBT beginning in January 2014**

Both the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) and Fundamentals of Surveying (FS) examinations will be offered for the last time in its paper-and-pencil format in October 2013. Beginning in January 2014 these examinations will be administered using computer based testing. The transition to computer based examinations will allow greater scheduling flexibility for examinees, more uniformity in testing conditions and enhanced security for exam content.

### **Software Engineering PE Exam Available beginning April 2013**

The new PE examination in software engineering will be administered beginning April 2013. The exam will be administered once a year each April. The exam specifications are available online at [ncees.org/exams](http://ncees.org/exams). IEEE is planning to publish study materials for the exam later this year.

## **BOARD BENEFITS FROM THE NCEES LAW ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (CONTINUED)**

Enforcement Exchange for the first time and begin the process of implementing this vital program in their state.

The all-day Law Enforcement Program is always an informative and educational session which includes a broad range of topics such as current legal issues, topics which cover the basics of performing investigations and training topics for new investigators like *Engineering 101*. This year, I presented a training session entitled *The Investigative Process* where I shared how we conduct investigations in Oklahoma. Training opportunities for engineering and land surveying board investigators are rare, especially one like this that is taught by individuals currently in the practice.

These sessions are conducted annually by the NCEES Committee on Law Enforcement whose members study important disciplinary issues, and make recommendations to NCEES that will achieve more effective and uniform enforcement and for greater interstate coordination of enforcement actions. Robert Manchester, the Board's prosecuting attorney, is currently a member of that committee.

NCEES is actively involved in providing resources to equip licensing boards with the tools necessary to have effective enforcement programs. By participating and taking advantage of the NCEES programs, the Oklahoma Board will stay at the forefront of the best enforcement practices and be better equipped to fulfill our mission of protecting the public by advancing professionalism, ethics, and compliance with the laws and rules that govern the practices in Oklahoma.

## License Expirations

**EXPIRATION/REVOCATION** - Licenses may be revoked by the Board for non-payment of renewal fees. Licensees will be notified of revocation by mail. Typically this notification is mailed 10 days following expiration.

**RENEWALS** - Each license issued by the Board expires on the last day of the month in which renewal fees are due, and becomes invalid on that date unless paid. One notice of the renewal is sent by first class mail to the address of record in the board files. This in effect provides notice two months prior to revocation.

**REINSTATEMENT** - Former licensees whose certificates have expired and were revoked for failure to pay renewal fees and desire to reinstate shall make application for reinstatement within 180 days after expiration and pay the prescribed renewal fee and penalty. After 180 days, a new application will be required, which shall be considered specifically by the Board, both from the standpoint of competency and of character.

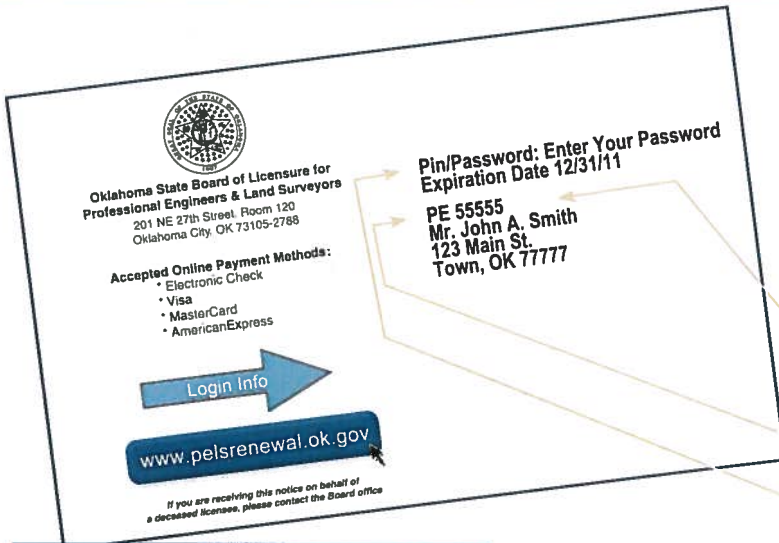

Effective August 24, 2012, O.S. Title 59, 475.15 was amended to include the following language, "A professional engineer, land surveyor or firm shall retain a hard copy or electronic copy of all technical submissions produced for a minimum of ten (10) years following the date of preparation."

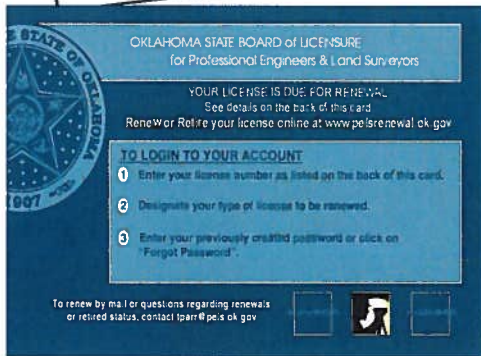
