NOTES FROM THE BOARD:

Certificate of Authorization Renewals:

Firm renewals were due for many firms on June 30, 2005. It would be a good idea for you all to check with your companies to make sure that they renewed their certificate of authorization, if necessary, to ensure that they are still in good standing with the Board. The firms that were not due June 30, 2005 will renew June 30, 2006.

Administrative Rule Changes:

Following the Public Meeting on January 13, 2006, the final draft of the proposed rule revisions was submitted to the Governor and Legislature for their approval. These rule revisions were driven by the revisions made to Title 59, 475.1 et seq. which went into effect November 1, 2005. We will keep you posted as to if and when they are approved by the legislature.

Ethical Marketing Rules for PE's and PLS's:

Just a reminder that Board Rules, Title 245 Subchapter 15 outlines the rules concerning ethical marketing of services for engineers and surveyors. Basically, the rule states that no engineer or surveyor can bid services to a governmental client. Governmental client is defines as "any federal state, county and city governmental bodies including, but not limited to, all departments, agencies, quasi public governmental agencies, authorities, sub-state planning districts, boards, commissions, offices, institutions, colleges, universities and all individuals acting under authority to represent such governmental bodies." January 3, 2006 - cut-off date for P.E. and L.S. applications for the April 21, 2006 exams AND the cut-off date for E.I. and L.S.I. applications for non full-time students for the April 22, 2006 exams.

February 5, 2006 - cut-off date for E.I. & L.S.I. applications for <u>full-time</u> <u>students</u> for the April 22, 2006 exams

June 1, 2006 - cut-off date for P.E. & L.S. applications for the October 27, 2006 exams AND the cut-off date for E.I. & L.S.I. applications for non full-time students for the October 28, 2006 exams.

Sept. 5, 2005 - cut-off date for E.I. & L.S.I. applications for full-time students for the October 28, 2006 exams.

License Expirations October 1, 2005 - December 31, 2005

EXPIRATION/REVOCATION - Licenses may be revoked by the Board for non-payment of renewal fees. Licensees will be notified of revocation by certified mail. Typically this notification is mailed 10 days following expiration.

RENEWALS - Each license issued by the Board expires on the last day of the month in which renewal fees are due, and becomes invalid on that date unless paid. One notice of the renewal is sent by first class mail to the address of record in the board files. This in effect provides notice two months prior to revocation. **REINSTATEMENT** - Former licensees whose licenses have expired and were revoked for failure to pay renewal fees and desire to reinstate shall make application for reinstatement within 180 days after expiration and pay the prescribed renewal fee and penalty. After 180 days, a new application will be required, which shall be considered by the Board.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIVITY

November 17-18, 2005

In the Matter of Earl F. McKinney, P.E. 10805; Case No. 2005-073; Summary of Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law; Earl F. McKinney, is found Guilty for violations in Kentucky which would have also been violations in the state of Oklahoma, and is hereby **Revoked**. The findings by the Kentucky Board are as follows:

- (1) Respondent was found guilty of making untruthful assertions in the annual renewals of his NCEES Record.
- (2) Respondent was found guilty of making untruthful statements when testifying before the Nevada PE & LS Board and applying for a license in California.
- (3) Respondent was found guilty of signing and sealing plans without first reviewing the plans.
- (4) Respondent was found guilty of sealing a survey plat for three lots with his Kentucky engineering seal when he is not a licensed land surveyor.
- (5) Respondent was found guilty in Texas of erroneously sealing and stamping plans outside his discipline on two occasions with respect to surveys.
- (6) Respondent was found guilty in Texas of providing false information to the Board.
- (7) Respondent was found guilty in Nevada of signing and sealing electrical plans when he was not licensed to do so.

A joint communication by the Board of Governors of Licensed Architects and Landscape Architects and Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors to keep you informed of current happenings important to your professions.

Currently the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors is forming a task force, Chaired by Bill McVey, PE, Board Member, to draft a policy designed to give guidance to local building and fire officials concerning when a P.E. is required to design a fire sprinkler system. Representatives of several different groups, including professional engineers, architects, representatives from the State Fire Marshal's office, members of fire protection societies, and fire protection contractors are being asked to participate in this endeavor.

More may be accomplished by this task force than a policy. Recently the state of Tennessee adopted a Standard of Care, which sets forth the

minimum requirements for design of fire protection systems. Iowa curently passed legislation that requires a person to not act as a fire extinguishing system contractor unless certified to do so. The NCEES recently adopted a policy statement concerning fire protection engineering. Other states have drafted, or are currently looking at, similar types of policies and legislation.

The task force will begin by opening a line of communication between the different parties involved in fire protection and see where the most effective changes may be made. This is just the first step in this process, which is aimed at protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the public, which is our ultimate goal.

CORRECTIONS TO THE A/E REGULATIONS BROCHURE (reprinted from the Fall 2005 Newsletter)

Two (2) items in need of correction have been identified in the A/E Regulations Brochure.

- (1) "Must Professional Corporations Use Corporate Seals on Plans?" The "e" statement should have read "No. However, all firms must include the certificate of authorization number and date of expiration, along with the registrant's seal, handwritten signature, and handwritten date of signature."
- (2) "Plans for Churches, Commercial & Educational Structures Less Than \$40,000 in Value?" the answer given applies to architects only. The engineering answer can be found on the reverse side of the brochure, which answers the question as to when different disciplines of engineers are needed.

We apologize for any confusion this caused, and will correct these items in the next printing of the brochure.
