COMMEMORATING 50 YEARS OF SURVEYING LICENSURE

Serving as a land surveyor member of the Board, and also as Board Chair for 2017-2018, I have the privilege of kicking off the commemoration of the 50th anniversary of surveying licensure in the state of Oklahoma.

April 28, 1968, Governor Dewey F. Bartlett, Sr. signed this legislation into law. In that same year, Leslie (Les) Judd, P.L.S. was appointed to the Board as its first surveyor member, and served until 1979 as the sole surveyor member on the Board. In 1979, Donald Vick, P.E, P.L.S, was appointed to fill Mr. Judd's position, and served in that capacity until 1991. In 1982, the statute was amended to allow for 2 surveyor members of the Board, at which time Jim Helmert, P.L.S., was appointed to the new position and served from 1982-1991, along beside Mr. Vick. In 1991, Bruce Pitts, P.L.S. and I were appointed

to the Board as surveyor members. Bruce Pitts served from 1991 – 2000 and I served terms from 1991-1997, and 2000-present. Ted Sack, P.L.S. was appointed in 1997 and served until 2015. Our newest surveyor member of the Board is Aaron Morris, P.L.S, who was appointed in 2015 and continues to actively serve on the Board.

These are the individuals who have worked alongside other leaders in the surveying community to formulate the basis for surveying licensure in Oklahoma for the past 50 years. Besides the licensure law, legislation was effective on October 1, 1978 creating the Corner Perpetuation and Filing Act, and in 1993 the first Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Land Surveying were enacted. I have been honored to be a part of the practice of engineering and land surveying in the state of Oklahoma and equally as honored to have served as a land surveyor member of the Oklahoma State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.

PROPOSED ADMINISTRATIVE RULE REVISIONS PUBLIC MEETING ANNOUNCED

On November 1, 2017, the proposed revisions to Title 59, 475.1 et seq. which regulate the practice of engineering and land surveying, became effective. This revision required a very comprehensive review and rewrite of the statutes and spanned several years' worth of work and input from many different organizations, individuals, and legislators.

With such a complete rewrite of the statutes, the same type of comprehensive review and rewrite of the administrative rules must be performed. In this regard, the Oklahoma State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors is extending its original written comment period to March 28, 2018, with an opportunity to present oral comments to the Board on March 29, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. at the Oklahoma Engineering and Design Professionals Center (address below). Oral comments are limited to 5 minutes and you must sign in at the door to make oral comments. ROBERT C. ZAHL, P.E. – HONORED BY THE BOARD

The Board recently honored Robert C. Zahl, P.E., who completed his third term as an engineer board member on June 28, 2017. Mr. Zahl was originally appointed to the Board by Governor Brad Henry, to serve a term from 1999-2005, and was reappointed by Governor Henry for a second term, to serve from 2005-2011. Governor Mary Fallin appointed him to a third term, to serve from 2011 – 2017.

During Mr. Zahl's 18 year tenure on the Board, he served with distinction as an Oklahoma Board Member at the state level. As a leader of the Board, he served as its Chair on 3 occasions, and participated in all aspects of the responsibilities of a board member, including outreach, licensing, enforcement, and legislative endeavors. As an active member of NCEES, he served on many NCEES Committees and in positions of leadership within the committees. For his exemplary service to the NCEES, he was awarded the NCEES Southern Zone Distinguished Service Award and NCEES Distinguished Service Award in 2010.

Mr. Zahl was one of the founding principals of Zahl-Ford, Inc., an Oklahoma City based structural engineering consulting firm, which in 2014 became ZFI Engineering, Inc. He recently retired and formed a new firm, Robert C. Zahl, PE, PLLC, a structural engineering firm which will conduct investigative engineering services and performing expert witness services for litigation situations, as well as perform structural design services related to renovations and remodels on small commercial structures and residential structures.

Chris Ramseyer, Ph.D., P.E.

The Board Welcomes Newly Appointed Board Member Chris Ramseyer, Ph.D., P.E.

Dr. Ramseyer is an Associate Professor and the Director of the Fears Structural Engineering Laboratory at the University of Oklahoma. He started teaching at OU in the School of Civil Engineering and Environmental Science in 2000. Dr. Ramseyer's achievements in teaching have been recognized by awards including the CEES George W. Tauxe Outstanding Professor Award in 2004 & 2011 and the College of Engineering Alumni Teaching Award in 2007. In the structural design realm, he was the lead structural engineer for the award winning SkyDance Bridge in Oklahoma City. And he received the University of Oklahoma Vice President for Research Award for Improving Quality of Life and

Communities for his work on tornado – structure interaction following the May 20th, 2013 tornado in Moore, Oklahoma.

Dr. Ramseyer is a leading researcher of the engineering properties of Calcium SulphoAluminate cements. His other major research interests include concrete materials with an emphasis on shrinkage compensating concrete, rapid setting concrete and early strength fly ash concrete; structural concrete with an emphasis on shrinkage, dimensional stability (warping and curling) and fatigue; the rehabilitation and repair of pavement and bridges and lateral load resistance of structures due to high wind events.

In addition to his teaching career at the University of Oklahoma, Dr. Ramseyer is a Licensed Professional Engineer in OK, TX, CA and WY. He was chair of the 2009 and 2015 IRC Building Technical Review Committee for the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission. He was involved in the development of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation – 2009 Specification as part of the Section 500 (Bridges) Committee. He is the only structural engineer that participated in both the NSF RAPID residential evaluation and ASCE/SEI school/commercial structure evaluation of the May 20th, 2013 tornado in Moore, Oklahoma. Dr. Ramseyer helped develop the City of Moore enhanced building code for tornadoes and developed the Residential Tornado Provisions of the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission adoption of the 2015 International Residential Code.

Dr. Ramseyer received his bachelors, Masters and Ph.D. from the University of Oklahoma in the field of civil engineering. In addition to the typical teaching responsibilities of a professor, a major focus of Dr. Ramseyer's has been in cultivating the next generation of civil engineers. Over the course of the last 19 years, he has had 65+ undergrad research assistants and has had 43 graduate research assistants. As part of his tenure at OU, he has been the faculty advisor to OU ASCE concrete canoe & steel bridge competition teams for 18 years and helped engineering club with fundraising activities at OU home football games for 10 years. In his spare time, he enjoys travelling with his wife and bird watching.

Remembering Charles L. Kimberling, P.E., P.L.S.

Former Oklahoma Board Member and past NCEES President Charles Kimberling passed away on June 15, 2017 at the age of 89. Mr. Kimberling was first appointed to the Board in 1974 by Governor David Hall. He was subsequently reappointed by Governor David Boren in 1976, Governor George Nigh in 1979 and 1985 and Governor Henry Bellmon in 1990. He served as the Board’s Chairman in 1978-1979, 1983-1984, and 1989-1990. Along with his numerous contributions to engineering and surveying licensure in Oklahoma, Mr. Kimberling served on many committees of the NCEES, as the NCEES Southern Zone Vice President in 1987-1988, and as NCEES President in 1988-1989. He continued to be active the rest of his life as an emeritus member of both the Oklahoma Board and NCEES, attending board meetings and both NCEES Southern Zone and annual meetings. Mr. Kimberling will be remembered forever for his exemplary leadership, his passion for public service, and his valuable lifelong contributions to the professions of engineering and surveying.

PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICE OF ENGINEERING EXAMS

- The Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) Exams are administered twice a year in pencil-and-paper format at the University of Central Oklahoma. All disciplines are NOT offered at each test administration. See the chart listed below for the testing schedule for each exam discipline.
- The PE Chemical Exam transitions to a year round computer based format in January 2018. The PE Nuclear Exam is scheduled to transition to a computer-based format in October 2018, but will only be administered once a year.

All applicants for the PE Exams, whether the exam is administered by pencil-and-paper or computer based testing, must have their applications approved by the Board prior to registering for the exam with NCEES.

Application Deadline – June 1, 2018 (Aug. 1, 2018 deadline for summer graduates)

NCEES SE Structural Component – Vertical Forces – October 26, 2018; Lateral Forces – October 27, 2018

EARLY TAKING OF THE PE EXAMS – As an applicant, you may decide you are prepared to take the PE exam, after completing your qualifying degree and passing the FE exam, without obtaining all of your requisite experience for licensure.

- If you are an early taker, we recommend you submit your completed application and all required information to this office by January 1, 2018 or July 1, 2018 for the paper-and-pencil exams offered in April and October.
- If you are an early taker applying for the PE Chemical Exam (administered by CBT year-round) you should submit your application to us one month prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board. Board meeting dates are located on the homepage of our website at www.pels.ok.gov
- If you are an early taker applying for the PE Nuclear Exam (administered by CBT in October only) you should submit your application to this office by July 1, 2018 for the October 26, 2018 exam.

FUNDAMENTALS OF ENGINEERING (FE) EXAM and FUNDAMENTALS OF SURVEYING (FS) EXAM

- The FE Exam and FS Exam are administered using Computer Based Testing and are offered year-round. No prior approval of applications is required to register with NCEES for these exams. You may apply to the Board for certification as an Engineer Intern or Land Surveyor Intern following completion of your education and examination requirements at www.pels.ok.gov

PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICE OF SURVEYING EXAM and OLS Exam

- The Principles and Practice of Surveying Exam (PS) is administered using Computer Based Testing and is offered year-round. You must have your application approved by the Board prior to registering for the exam with NCEES. You should submit your application to us one month prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.
- To apply for the Oklahoma Law and Surveying Exam (OLS) you must have your application approved by the Board in order to be admitted to sit for the exam. You should submit your application to us one month prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.
- Board meeting dates are located on the homepage of our website www.pels.ok.gov
- The 2018 OLS testing dates are: January 31, April 12, August 1, and October 25

New Statutory Requirements for Managing Agents of Firms

In the last edition of this newsletter, I wrote about the importance of licensees practicing faithful responsible charge over the engineering and surveying projects they sign and seal. Nothing can provide greater public protection than licensees fully executing their responsibilities with respect to responsible charge over a project. But there is further responsibility for licensees who have been designated managing agent for a firm which holds an Oklahoma Certificate of Authorization. By statute the P.E. or P.L.S. so designated must **NOT** be a licensee who is self-employed, an independent contractor or a licensee who renders consulting engineering or surveying services to, or for a firm. The managing

agent **must** hold a position of recognized authority within the firm, and is responsible for:

1. Renewal of the firm's certificate of authorization, and notification to the Board of any change in managing agent or firm's contact information;
2. Overall administrative supervision of the firm's licensed and subordinate personnel performing engineering or surveying work in Oklahoma; and
3. The institution of and adherence to policies of the firm that are in accordance with Section 475.1 et seq. of Title 59 O.S., Section 3-116 et seq. of Title 65 O.S. and the rules of the Board.

The purpose of this rule is to provide guidance and clarity to licensees concerning their responsibilities towards keeping their firm in compliance with Board regulations including the Rules of Professional Conduct. This will have little effect on smaller firms where a licensee is already performing all these functions. But for larger firms, particularly those with offices in several locations, the managing agent is needed to assure that an Oklahoma licensee in that firm will be paying attention to the licensing status of the firm and that Oklahoma laws and rules are being followed.

The law requires that the individual designated as managing for the firm has the authority to make engineering and surveying decisions, as they pertain to paragraphs 1 through 3 above. Experience has shown us that this is necessary, particularly when it comes to paragraph 3 above, because licensees know and *care* that the standing of their personal and firm licenses depend upon their firm's professional and ethical conduct when dealing with other licensees, clients, and most importantly the public interest.

Having licensed managing agents in charge of firms' policies towards Board laws and rules is in the best interest of serving the public because the licensee alone understands that their primary obligation is the protection of the health, safety, property and welfare of the public. The obligation to meet this Board requirement will give the licensed managing agents the support they need to forcefully confront the ethical and professional issues raised by technological and engineering and surveying activity arising with the firm.

Josh Burge, P.L.S. 1762, Case No. 2016-059

Through Consent: Josh Burge failed to comply with the Continuing Education audit by not providing acceptable proof of obtaining the required PDH's he certified he completed when renewing his Professional Land Surveyor Certificate of Licensure. In this regard, Burge was found **Guilty**, assessed an administrative penalty of \$1,500 and will be included in the subsequent applicable audit cycle.

Charles Barker, P.E. 16332, Case No. 2016-060

Through Consent: Charles Barker failed to comply with the Continuing Education audit by not providing acceptable proof of obtaining the required PDH's he certified he completed when renewing his Professional Engineer Certificate of Licensure. In this regard, Barker was found **Guilty**, assessed an administrative penalty of \$2,000, and will be included in the subsequent applicable audit cycle.

Emmanuel Lao Casino, P.E. 24196, Case No. 2016-062

Through Consent: Emmanuel Lao Casino failed to comply with the Continuing Education audit by not providing acceptable proof of obtaining the required PDH's he certified he completed when renewing his Professional Engineer Certificate of Licensure. In this regard, Casino was found **Guilty**, assessed an administrative penalty of \$1,500 and will be included in the subsequent applicable audit cycle.

Kevin Pegues, P.E. 24301, Case No. 2016-088

Through Consent: Kevin Pegues violated the laws and rules of another state which violations are the same or substantially equivalent to Oklahoma Statutes and Rules. In this regard, Pegues was found **Guilty**; his Certificate of Licensure was placed on Probation to run concurrently with the Texas Agreed Board Order in TBPE Case No. D-35654 subject to the same terms and conditions as contained in the Texas Order, including **Cease and Desist** from designing buildings over one (1) story tall with an importance factor greater the one (1). Pegues was further ordered to successfully complete the Texas Tech University Engineering Ethics Course Level I and was **Reprimanded**.

Stout & Henry Surveying, Inc., CA 3798 and Allen E. Henry, P.L.S. 1335, Case No. 2017-010

Through Consent: Allen E. Henry failed to follow the requirements of the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Land Surveying and failed to follow the requirements for Mortgage Inspection Reports which were acts that evidences a disregard or indifference to the rules or statutes governing the practice of land surveying and constitutes misconduct. In this regard, Henry was found **Guilty**, assessed an administrative penalty of \$1,000 and was hereby **Reprimanded**. Stout & Henry Surveying, Inc. failed to follow the Oklahoma Minimum Standards for the Practice of Land Surveying and the requirements for Mortgage Inspection Reports which were acts that evidence a disregard or indifference to the rules or statutes governing the practice of land surveying and constitutes misconduct. OAR: 245: 15-7-1(c) states, "When a professional engineer or land surveyor in good standing desires to retire his or her license, he or she may do so upon application to the Board, subject to reinstatement and continuing education requirements by the Board." **PLEASE NOTE: If you renew your license and certify that you have met the continuing education requirements, you shall NOT be allowed to retire your license in lieu of an administrative action if you are chosen for audit and do not have the required hours.**
