



FOREIGN PHARMACY GRADUATE Requirements for Licensure

- Applicant must have successfully completed the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) Foreign Pharmacy graduate Equivalency Certification (FPGEC) after passing the TOEFL and the FPGE exams.
- Applicant must submit a written request for an intern license to the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy which must include their NABP e-Profile number and current address.
- Upon verification of the FPGEC certification, the applicant will receive an application for an Oklahoma intern license.

Applicant must be one of the following:

1. Be a citizen or national of the United States.
2. An alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence.
3. An alien authorized by the Immigration and Naturalization Service to work in the US.

- Applicant must complete 1000 hours of training as an Oklahoma intern within 1 year of licensure.
- Upon successful completion of training, applicant may apply to sit for the pharmacist licensure exam in Oklahoma.

1. Written request for an intern license including the applicants NABP e-Profile number and current address.
2. Oklahoma intern license.
3. 1000 intern hours.
4. Application for Oklahoma pharmacist licensure exam.
