FOREIGN PHARMACY GRADUATE Requirements for Licensure by Reciprocity

- Applicant must have successfully completed the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) Foreign Pharmacy graduate Equivalency Certification (FPGEC) after passing the TOEFL and the FPGE exams.
- Applicant must complete a Preliminary Application for Transfer of Pharmacist Licensure and an application for the Oklahoma Multi-State Jurisprudence Exam (MPJE). Applications must be completed on NABP's website at www.nabp.pharmacy. Upon verification, NABP will send the applicant an Official Application for Transfer of Pharmacist Licensure to be submitted to the Oklahoma Board of Pharmacy.
(Please see NABP website for more detailed information)
- Upon the Oklahoma Board of Pharmacy receiving the "NABP Official Application for Licensure Transfer", the Board will verify the FPGEC Certification number listed on the application with NABP. Once verification has been received, the applicant will be made eligible for the Oklahoma Multi-State Jurisprudence Exam (MPJE)
- Upon the Board receiving a passing MPJE score, applicant will be scheduled to appear before the Board for a Board interview.

Applicant must be one of the following:

1. Be a citizen or national of the United States.
2. An alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence.
3. An alien authorized by the Immigration and Naturalization Service to work in the US.

2. Apply online with NABP for License Transfer and the Oklahoma MPJE.
3. Interview with the Oklahoma Board of Pharmacy.
