

### **Information for OSBP Licensees Regarding APRNs with Prescriptive Authority**

The following information was provided by the Board of Nursing regarding the implementation of recent legislation ([HB 2298](#), effective November 1, 2025, codified in the Oklahoma Statutes at: Title 59, Sections [567.4c](#), [567.5b](#), [567.5c](#), [479.1](#), [567.3a](#), [567.4a](#), and [567.5a](#); **Title 59, Sections 353.1 and 353.1a of the Oklahoma Pharmacy Act**; and Title 63, Section [2-312](#)), which provides an option for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs) to obtain independent prescriptive authority.

Please note the following regarding APRNs (CNP, CNM, CNS) who have been granted prescriptive authority by the Oklahoma Board of Nursing (BON):

1. Independent prescriptive authority recognition may be verified on the BON's licensing verification page which may be accessed here: [License Lookup](#).
2. APRNs (CNP, CNM, CNS) who have been granted independent prescriptive authority are not required to have or list a supervising physician on their prescriptions but should include the following information on all prescriptions:
  1. Name, title, address, and telephone number of the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse who is prescribing.
  2. The notation of "Independent Rx Authority".
  3. Name of the client.
  4. Date of the prescription.
  5. Full name of the drug, dosage, route and specific directions for administration.
  6. DEA number of Advanced Practice Registered Nurse, if required.
  7. Written prescriptions shall include the signature of the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse.
  8. Records of all prescriptions will be documented in client records.
