## VICTIM NOTIFICATION PLEASE RETAIN THIS INFORMATION SHEET FOR YOUR RECORDS

If the person who has committed the crime against you is ordered to serve time in the state prison system, then you should know about Victim Notification. Very simply, Victim Notification is the request to receive notifications of pardon, parole, and other hearings before the Pardon and Parole Board on incarcerated offenders as well as status changes within the Department of Corrections (DOC). Each agency listed is a separate state agency that performs different and distinct services to crime victims and survivors. Please feel free to contact each agency for specific questions on specific cases.

Some victims and survivors do not want to receive information and that is their right. If you do, however, just telling the court or others that you desire information is not sufficient. Unless you complete the form, the Pardon and Parole Board and the DOC are not provided with your name, interest in notification, or how to contact you. Below are the different agencies that notify victims of an offender's involvement in the post-incarceration systems:

- 1. **PARDON AND PAROLE BOARD (PPB):** After completing and submitting the attached form, the PPB will notify you prior to any parole proceedings and actions regarding pardon, parole and commutation before the Board. - 2. **DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (DOC):** After completing and submitting the attached form, the DOC will notify you regarding any custody or status of offenders who are incarcerated or under the supervision of the DOC. - 3. **OK VINE:** OK <u>Victim Information and Notification Everyday</u> (VINE) is a criminal tracking and notification system. OK VINE is a free, 24-hour, confidential service which uses computer technology to automatically notify interested parties about changes in an offender's custody status. Custody status changes covered under OK VINE include offender transfer, escape, apprehension, release, or death. To register for OK VINE, call, 1-877-654-8463 or go to www.vinelink.com. **IMPORTANT NOTICE** – If an inmate is transferred from DOC into any Department of Mental Health facility, **VINE** is no longer activated until that offender goes back into DOC custody.

4. **DEATH PENALTY CASES:** To receive notification regarding an offender's death penalty case appeal, use the attached form. The PPB will forward the form to the Office of the Attorney General. You will be notified when significant events occur (briefs filed, oral arguments, opinions issued, execution dates, etc.).
