Each speaker will be allocated three (3) minutes for presentation. The Chairperson may interrupt and/or terminate any presentation during public comment which does not conform to the procedures outlined under this Section. The Chairperson reserves and retains the right to limit the comment time available to ensure efficiency of the meeting and to interrupt, terminate, or postpone public comment as necessary to effectuate the management of the public meeting.
