Gold Star Family License Plate Instructions

Gold Star Family License Plates – such plates shall be designed to honor the surviving family of an honorably discharged veteran who died due to or as a consequence of a service-connected injury, illness or disease. Families may apply for no more than two (2) license plates which shall be displayed on vehicles with a rate carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. As used in this paragraph, “qualified veteran” shall mean:

- a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces or as a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result of the performance of duties for any branch of the United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard while on active military duty, or
- b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces or as a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of injury, illness or disease caused by the performance of such duties while on active duty, whether the death occurred while on active duty or after the honorable discharge of such person.

The required supporting documentation:

- **Parents:**
Gold Star Parent Membership card, **or**
Birth certificate of Service Member, **and** DD Form 1300.
- **Siblings and Half-Siblings:**
Birth certificate of Service Member, **and** birth certificate of Family Member applicant, **and** DD Form 1300.
- **Maternal Grandparents:**
Birth certificate of Service Member, **and** birth certificate of Service Member’s mother, **and** DD Form 1300.
- **Paternal Grandparents:**
Birth certificate of Service Member, **and** birth certificate of Service Member’s father, **and** DD Form 1300.

Gold Star Survivor and Surviving Spouse License Plate Instructions

Gold Star Survivor - Surviving Spouse License Plates – such plates shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of an honorably discharged veteran who died due to or as a consequence of a service-connected injury, illness or disease. Such surviving spouse or children may apply for a Surviving Spouse/Survivor license plate for any vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; As used in this paragraph, “qualified veteran” shall mean:

- a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces or as a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result of the performance of duties for any branch of the United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard while on active military duty, or
- b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces or as a member of the Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of injury, illness or disease caused by the performance of such duties while on active duty, whether the death occurred while on active duty or after the honorable discharge of such person.

The required supporting documentation:

- Birth Certificate confirming applicant’s relationship (Children requesting a Gold Star Survivor Plate), **and**, one of the following:
- DD Form 1300, Report of Casualty, **or**
- Death Certificate, DD Form 214 and a statement veteran’s death was due to or a consequence of a service-connected disability, **or**
- A letter of confirmation from the Oklahoma Department of Veteran Affairs.
