Oklahoma Tax Commission Regular Meeting Minutes March 1, 2018

- 1. The regularly scheduled meeting of the Oklahoma Tax Commission convened at 1:30 p.m., on the above date, in the Oklahoma City office. Notice of said meeting and the agenda therefor were posted in prominent public view at the Commission's principal office in Oklahoma City from and after 1:30 p.m., on February 28, 2018.
 - Chairman Burrage called the meeting to order. Other members present were Vice-Chairman Jolley and Secretary-Member Kemp. Also present were Lee Pugh, General Counsel and Ernest Short, Counsel to the Commissioners.
- 2. Secretary-Member Kemp moved to approve the minutes of the regular commission meeting of February 27, 2018. Chairman Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 3. Executive Directors Report; Personnel Appointments:
