## Oklahoma Tax Commission Meeting Minutes May 5, 2020

- 1. The regularly scheduled meeting of the Oklahoma Tax Commission convened at 1:30 p.m., on the above date, virtually. Notice of said meeting and the agenda therefor were posted in prominent public view at the Commission's principal office in Oklahoma City from and after 1:30 p.m. on May 4, 2020.
  - Chairman Prater called the meeting to order. Other members present were Vice-Chairman Jolley and Secretary-Member Burrage. Also present was Ernest Short, Counsel to the Commissioners. (All members attending virtually.)
- 2. Vice-Chairman Jolley moved to approve the minutes of the regular commission meeting on April 28, 2020. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 3. There was no report from the Executive Director.
- 4. Chairman Prater moved that the Commission resolve into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing confidential taxpayer matters and proceedings. Vice-Chairman Jolley seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- An executive session was held, after which the Commission returned to open meeting.

- 8. Amendments to Commission Order 2020-03-19-04 to correspond with IRS Notice 2020-23 were not discussed.
- 9. Excise taxes were not discussed.
- 10. There was no report from Tax Policy and Research.
- 11. Secretary-Member Burrage moved to approve Internal Audit reports on 1) Business Operations Division Surprise Cash Count and 2) Business Operations Division Travel Claims. Chairman Prater seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
