## Oklahoma Tax Commission Meeting Minutes May 12, 2020

- 1. The regularly scheduled meeting of the Oklahoma Tax Commission convened at 1:30 p.m., on the above date, virtually. Notice of said meeting and the agenda therefor were posted in prominent public view at the Commission's principal office in Oklahoma City from and after 1:30 p.m. on May 11, 2020.
  - Chairman Prater called the meeting to order. Other members present were Vice-Chairman Jolley and Secretary-Member Burrage. Also present were Ernest Short, Counsel to the Commissioners and Joseph Gappa, General Counsel. (All members attending virtually.)
- 2. Vice-Chairman Jolley moved to approve the minutes of the regular commission meeting on May 5, 2020. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 3. There was no report from the Executive Director.
- 4. Chairman Prater moved that the Commission resolve into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing confidential taxpayer matters and proceedings. Vice-Chairman Jolley seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.

An executive session was held, after which the Commission returned to open meeting.

- 5. Recommendations from Executive Session:
  - 1) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission grant a waiver of one-fourth delinquent interest in the amount of \$1,032.39, upon payment of three-fourths delinquent interest, plus underestimation interest, delinquent penalty, warrant penalty, filing fees and applicable collection fees, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 19-1364815. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
  - 2) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission deny a waiver request, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 19-1410266. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
  - 3) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission cap the interest to the amount of tax and grant a waiver of one-fourth recalculated delinquent interest, in Case No. 20-1088892. Chairman Prater seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, abstain. The motion was declared adopted.

- 4) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission grant a waiver of one-half delinquent interest in the amount of \$896.36, upon pyament of one-half delinquent interest, plus underestimation interest and delinquent penalty, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 20-1094966. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 5) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission grant a waiver of one-half delinquent interest in the amount of \$4,515.54, upon payment of one-half delinquent interest, plus underestimation interest and delinquent penalty, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 20-1153868. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 6) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission grant a waiver of one-half delinquent interest in the amount of \$3,731.47, upon payment of one-half delinquent intereset, plus underestimation interest and delinquent penalty, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 20-1221965. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 7) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission grant a waiver of one-half delinquent interest in the amount of \$1,955.84, upon payment of one-half delinquent interest, plus underestimation interest and delinquent penalty, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 20-1231284. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 8) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission cap the interest to the amount of tax and grant a waiver of one-half of the recalculated delinquent interest, upon payment of one-half delinquent interest, plus delinquent penalty, warrant penalty, filing fees and applicable collection fees, in Case No. 19-1389450. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 9) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission cap the interest to the amount of tax and grant a waiver of one-half of the capped interest in the amount of \$4,895.22, upon payment of remaining interest, plus delinquent penalty, warrant penalty, filing fees and applicable collection fees, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. 20-1461346. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 10) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission grant a partial release, as recommended by the Division, in Case No. PR-20-017. Secretary-Member

Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.

11) Case No. PR-20-022; On the advice of counsel, Secretary-Member Burrage recused himself and left the room.

Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission request additional information and continue the matter to May 19, 2020 meeting. Chairman Prater seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye. The motion was declared adopted.

- 12) Vice-Chairman Jolley moved that the Commission adopt the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of the Administrative Law Judge, in Case No. P-16-171-K. Secretary-Member Burrage seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 6. There was no report from Tax Policy and Research.
- 7. There were no other division reports.
- 8. New business: Chairman Prater advised the Commissioners regarding a study on effectiveness and efficiencies of collection procedures by Alvarez and Marsal; also requested the Commissioners review the Motor Vehicle report and submit any comments to the Executive Director.
