OKLAHOMA TAX COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING MINUTES May 4, 2021

- 1. The regularly scheduled meeting of the Oklahoma Tax Commission convened at 1:30 p.m., on the above date. Notice of said meeting was posted on December 3, 2020 and the agenda therefor was posted online from and after 1:30 p.m. on May 3, 2021. Chairman Jolley declared the presence of a quorum.
 - Persons in attendance: Chairman Jolley, Vice-Chairman Paulk, Secretary-Member Prater, Elizabeth Field.
- 2. READING OF MINUTES Vice-Chairman Paulk moved to approve the minutes of the regular commission meeting on April 27, 2021. Secretary-Member Prater seconded the motion. The motion was declared adopted on a voice vote.
- 3. Secretary-Member Prater moved that the Commission resolve into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing confidential taxpayer matters and proceedings. Vice-Chairman Paulk seconded the motion. The motion was declared adopted on a voice vote.

An executive session was held, after which the Commission returned to open meeting.
