- 2. READING OF MINUTES Secretary-Member Prater moved to approve the minutes of the regular commission meeting on July 6, 2021. Vice-Chairman Paulk seconded the motion. Chairman, aye; Vice-Chairman, aye; Secretary-Member, aye. The motion was declared adopted.
- 3.
