State Tax Revenue Report

April 2026

“April reflects a strong tax season in Oklahoma’s revenue, with income tax driving a significant increase in overall revenues. Oklahoma remains well-positioned as we move into the second quarter of 2026.”

April Revenue:
\$ 2,483,132,950.71

- Revenue total of **\$17.79B** for the last 12 months, an increase of \$894.6M, or **5.3%**, over the last year.
- Year-over-year monthly comparisons show an overall increase of \$467.8M or **23.2%**.
- Increase in revenue of **76.1%** over last month.
- Four tax sources increased over the last month:
 - Total *Income Tax* of \$1.5B **up 185.9%**,
 - Total *Sales and Use Tax* of \$626.0M **up 10.1%**,
 - Gross Production Tax of \$109.2M **up 1.2%**,
 - *Other Tax Sources* of \$144.2M **up 21.1%** and
 - *Motor Vehicle Tax* of \$78.2M down 3.3%.

After a steadier pace early in the year, revenue growth strengthened in March and accelerated sharply in April. The increase marks a clear step up in the rolling 12-month total, indicating strong momentum and a more robust revenue trajectory heading into the second quarter.

New orders remain strong while the drop appears driven more by an inventory correction and shifting supply dynamics rather than a collapse in demand. Rising claims suggest conditions may be weakening more broadly.



About the State Tax Revenue Report

Formally known as the Gross Receipts Report, this report is a timely, broad view of the state's economy and releases in conjunction with the General Revenue Fund report. Providing information to state agencies for budgetary planning purposes, the General Revenue Fund acts as the state's main operating account and receives a portion of the state's gross receipts as well as state, city and county funds.

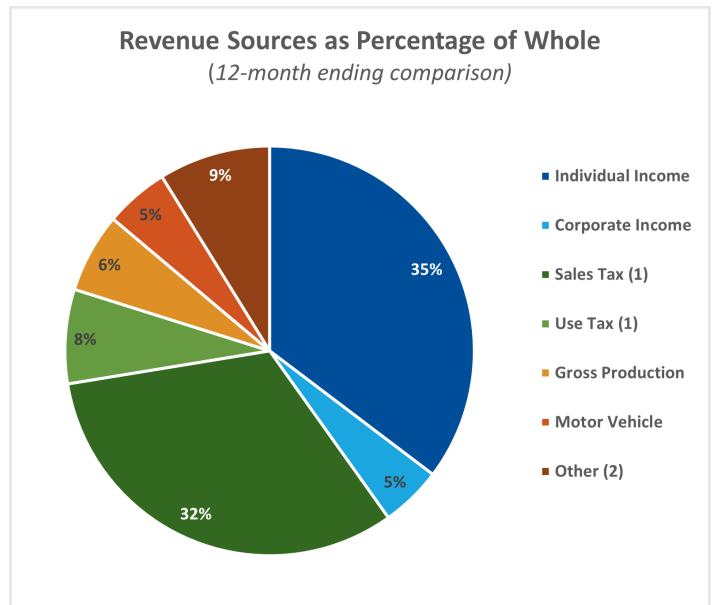

12-Month Period End Comparison

Tax revenue total of **\$17.79 billion, up \$894.6 million or 5.3 percent.**

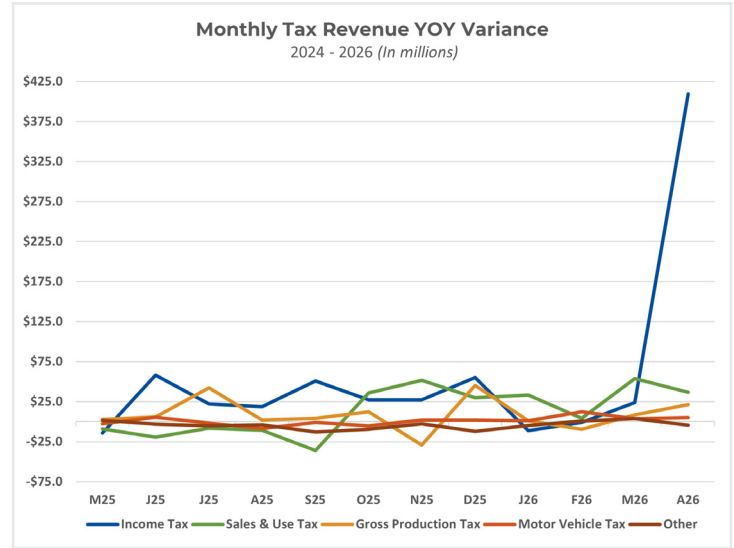
- Combined **individual income tax** and **corporate income tax** of \$7.1 billion, up \$665.6 million or 10.3 percent.
 - o **Individual tax** of \$6.3 billion, up \$701.0 million or 12.6 percent.
 - o **Corporate tax** of \$861.9 million, down \$35.4 million or 3.9 percent.
- Combined **sales tax** and **use tax**, including city and county remittances, of \$7.1 billion, up \$161.7 million or 2.3 percent.
 - o **Sales tax** of \$5.7 billion, up \$71.7 million or 1.3 percent.
 - o **Use tax**, received on out-of-state and Internet purchases, of \$1.3 billion, up \$90.0 million or 7.3 percent.
- Oil and gas **gross production tax** of \$1.1 billion, up \$107.1 million or 10.6 percent.
- **Motor vehicle tax** of \$897.8 million, down \$12.4 million or 1.4 percent.
- **Other sources**, includes more than 70 revenue streams, of \$1.6 billion, down \$52.2 million or 3.2 percent.



Monthly Comparison

Tax revenue total of **\$2.5 billion, up \$467.8 million or 23.2 percent for April 2026 vs. 2025.**

- **Income tax** of \$1.5 billion, up \$409.4 million or 36.7 percent.
 - o **Individual tax** of \$1.4 billion, up \$474.8 million or 52.0 percent.
 - o **Corporate tax** of \$138.5 million, down \$65.4 million or 32.1 percent.
- **Sales and use tax** of \$626.0 million, up \$36.7 million or 6.2 percent.
 - o **Sales tax** of \$501.3 million, up \$19.9 million or 4.1 percent.
 - o **Use tax** of \$124.7 million, up \$16.8 million or 15.6 percent.
- **Gross production tax** of \$109.2 million, up \$21.2 million or 24.1 percent.
- **Motor vehicle tax** of \$78.2 million, up \$5.1 million or 7.0 percent.
- **Other sources** of \$144.2 million, down \$4.5 million or 3.1 percent.



Month-Over-Month Comparison

Tax Revenue total of **\$2.5 billion, up \$1.1 billion or 76.1 percent** from last month.

- Increase in **income tax** of \$992.0 million or 185.9%.
- Increase in **sales and use tax** of \$57.4 million or 10.1%.
- Increase in **gross production tax** of \$109.2 million or 1.2%.
- Decrease in **motor vehicle tax** of \$78.2 million or 3.3%.
- Increase in **other sources** of \$144.2 million or 21.1%.
