## To the People of Oklahoma:

The Office of the State Treasurer is pleased to issue the January monthly investment performance report. I trust you will find it thorough and in keeping with my commitment to provide disclosure of the economic environment and portfolio results. As always, my staff and I are available to answer any questions.

#### **Market Conditions**

The treasury curve remained inverted in short-term maturities. The spread between the 2-year and 10-year treasury was 0.17%, with the 2-year treasury ending the month at 2.46% and the benchmark 10-year earning 2.63%. The 30-year treasury was at 2.996%

The stock markets rebounded from a horrible performance in December as the benchmark S&P 500 posted its highest monthly gain since 2015. The S&P finished the month at 2,704, the Dow Jones was at 24,999 and the Nasdaq rose to 7,281. All three major indexes finished the month with positive returns of 7.9% by the S&P, 7.2% by the Dow and 9.7% by Nasdaq.

The interest rate remained unchanged at 2.50%, with Fed policies continuing to be data dependent. Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell said "we continue to expect that the American economy will grow at a solid pace in 2019, although likely slower than the very strong pace of 2018." The Fed had concerns in regard to the strength and volatility of the global financial outlook. Chairman Powell stated that "growth has slowed in some major foreign economies, particularly in China and Europe. There is elevated uncertainty around several unresolved government policy issues, including Brexit, ongoing trade negotiations, and the effects from the partial government shutdown in the United States."

## **Economic Developments**

The December unemployment rate increased by two-tenths to 3.9%. The rise in unemployment was attributed to the participation rate being the highest since 2017, coming in at 63.1% from 62.9%. According to Bloomberg, "nonfarm payrolls increased by 312,000 in December, easily topping all forecasts, after an upwardly revised 176,000 November gain. Average hourly earnings rose 3.2 percent from a year earlier, topping projections and matching the fastest pace since 2009."

The headline consumer price index (CPI) declined 0.1% in December and on a year-over-year basis increased 1.9%. This was the first time since March 2018 there was a drop in the CPI. The factors keeping inflation in check were the continued decrease in oil prices, due to oversupply and a reduction in global economic growth. Core inflation rose 0.2% for the month and in the twelve months through December gained 2.2%, reflecting no change from the previous month. The producer price index (PPI) at 0.2% posted the largest decline in five months, which was attributed to the plunge in gasoline prices. The core PPI, which strips out food, energy and trade margins, was flat for the month and year-over-year it was unchanged from November coming in at 2.8%.

The December retail sales number, which would have been issued in January by the U.S. Census Bureau, was postponed due to the partial government shutdown.

The National Association of Realtors (NAR) reported that existing-home sales declined in December, after rising the previous two months. The chief economist for NAR said "the housing market is obviously very sensitive to mortgage rate. Softer sales in December reflected consumer search processes and contract signing activity in previous months when mortgage rates were higher than today. Now, with mortgage rates lower, some revival in home sale sales is expected going into spring." Total existing-home inventory dropped to 1.55 million in December, from 1.74 million in the previous month.

The advanced estimate of the gross domestic product (GDP) for the fourth quarter of 2018, which would have been released by the Bureau of Economic Analysis on January 30, was postponed due to the partial government shutdown.

## Portfolio Commentary: Performance, Diversification, and Strategy

The Treasurer's portfolio yielded 2.53% in January with a weighted average maturity of 923 days. The total assets under management by the treasurer was \$6.74 billion, in comparison to \$5.71 billion a year ago. The portfolio's diversification strategy continues to be sound. U.S. government sponsored enterprises accounted for approximately 40% of the portfolio and mortgage-backed securities were 38%. Certificates of Deposits represented 2% of assets and money market mutual funds were 9%. U.S. treasuries, state bond issues, foreign bonds and municipals totaled 11% and comprised the balance of funds invested. In keeping with the state's statutory investment objectives, the portfolio strategy continues to be seeking safety, liquidity, and return on investment, in that order. Laddered bond maturities and a buy-and-hold strategy were utilized. Market observation for investment opportunities were considered in order to maximize income within investment parameters and with regard to the likelihood of slower rising interest rates.

#### Collateralization

All funds under the control of this office requiring collateralization were secured at rates ranging from 102% to 110%, depending on the type of investment.

## Payments, Fees, and Commissions

Securities were purchased or sold utilizing competitive bidding. Bank fees and money market mutual fund operating expenses are detailed in the attached pages, as is the earnings split between the treasurer and the master custodian bank on securities lending income.

### **Total Funds Invested**

Funds available for investment, at market value, include the State Treasurer's investments at \$4,041,409,206 and State Agency balances in OK Invest at \$2,700,587,249 for a total of \$6,741,996,455.

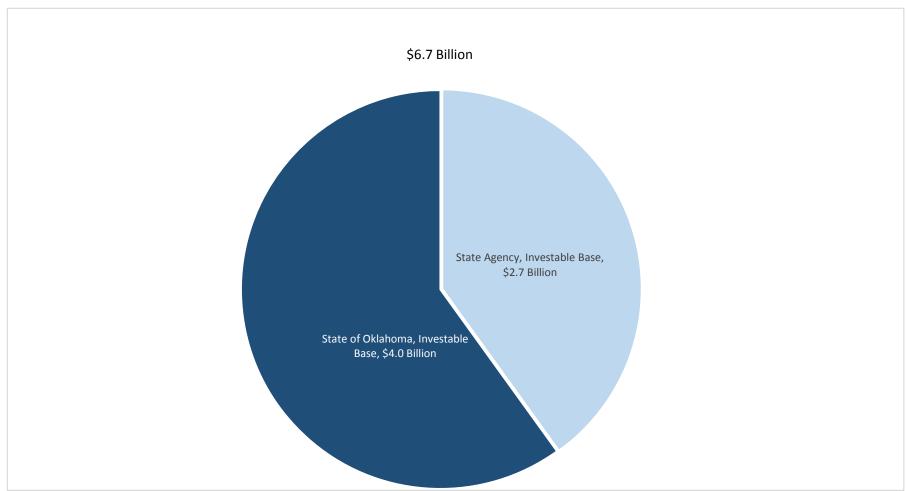

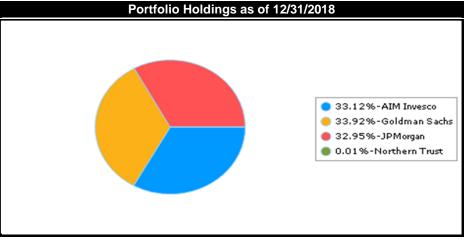


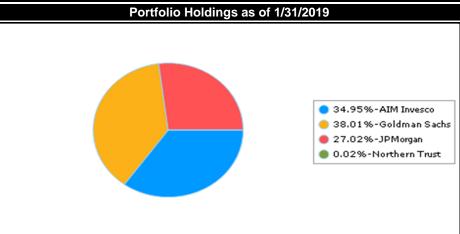


Distribution by Issuer - Market Value

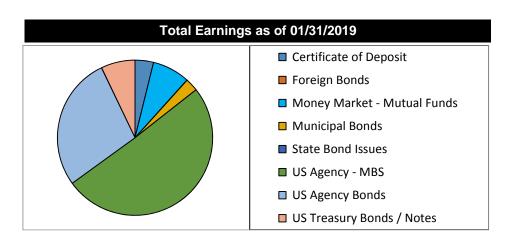

In February 2018, the Treasurer estimated earnings to the Board of Equalization for Fiscal Year 2019. The amount estimated was \$61,000,000. Year-to-date actual earnings are recorded on a cash basis of accounting.

The following page presents market rates of return on the Securities portion of the General Account and the State's aggregated State Agency Accounts. These figures, which are dollar-weighted and time-weighted where appropriate, are calculated using the percentage change in market value (inclusive of accrued income) from the end of the prior month to the end of the reporting month.

To ensure the integrity of data, this information is provided by the Treasurer's custodian bank acting in its capacity as an external third party. As such, performance measurement is presently confined to those investments which are held with the custodian bank Northern Trust Company.

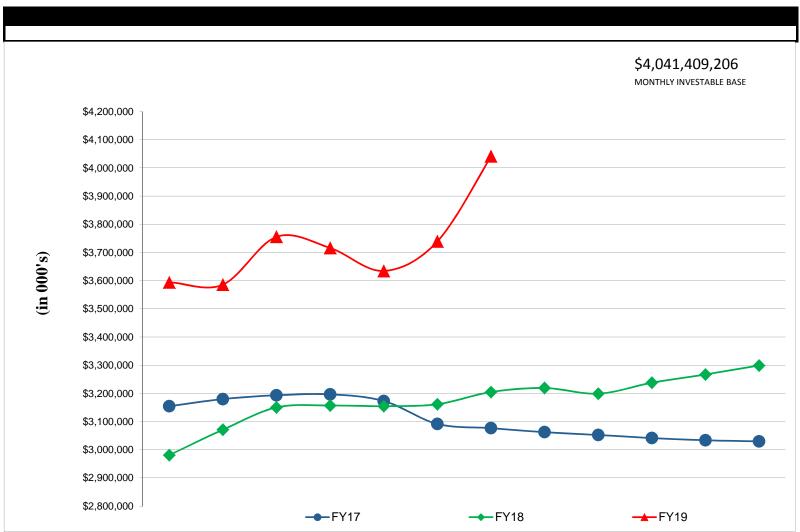

#### Securities Lending Program

The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Northern Trust Company acting as lending agent. Northern Trust retains 15% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the month was \$4,448. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains the first \$450,000 of security lending revenue in a revolving fund. These funds are used to pay custody and other banking fees. Any revenue not needed for this purpose is deposited to the General Fund.

#### Northern Trust Custody Fees

Pursuant to custodial contract with Northern Trust Company, custody fees are paid on a quarterly basis. Fees paid to Northern Trust Company for the first two quarters was \$22,500.
