To the People of Oklahoma:

The Office of the State Treasurer is pleased to issue the March monthly investment performance report. I trust you will find it thorough and in keeping with my commitment to provide disclosure of the economic environment and portfolio results. As always, my staff and I are available to answer any questions.

Market Conditions

The yield curve drew much attention as the spread between the 3-month and 10-year benchmark treasury tumbled below 0.10% for the first time since 2007. When ultra-short treasuries are earning almost equal to the benchmark, past history has reflected that a possible recession might occur in the U.S. during the next 18-months. The 3-month treasury finished the month at 2.389% in comparison to a yield of 2.406% for the 10-year treasury, along with the 30-year coming in at 2.815%.

The equity market closed March vigorously, reflecting its largest quarterly increase in a decade. The S&P 500 came in at 2,834, the Dow at 25,928 and the Nasdaq at 7,729. All three indexes had positive quarterly gains with the S&P earning 13.1%, the Dow at 11.2% and the Nasdaq returning 16.5%.

On March 20, the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) unanimously voted to keep the federal funds rate unchanged. According to Bloomberg News, “Federal Reserve officials scaled back their projected interest-rate increases this year to zero and said they would end the drawdown of the central bank’s bond holdings in September.” The Fed expressed concerns in regard to inflation due energy price declines and diminishing economic growth on a global basis.

Economic Developments

Job creation in February was a meagerly 20,000 in non-farm payrolls, the lowest since September 2017. Non-farm payrolls were upwardly revised by 7,000 in January and 5,000 in December. The unemployment rate declined by 0.1% to 3.8%. Another bright spot was that average hourly earnings gained 3.4% year-over-year, reflecting the highest growth in nearly 10 years.

The consumer price index (CPI) and the producer price index (PPI) both slightly rose by 0.2% and 0.1%, respectively. The CPI increase reflected the smallest annual gain in nearly 2-1/2 years and on a year-over-year basis it grew 1.5%, reflecting the smallest gain since September 2016. According to CNBC, “U.S. wholesale prices barely increased last month after falling for three straight months, a sign there is little inflation pressure in the economy.”

Retail sales figures were upwardly revised for January from 0.2% to 0.7%, but sales were lackluster dropping 0.2% in February. There were several reasons attributed to the sales decline such as delays in tax refund processing and blustery and raining weather in a large swath of the U.S. during the month. The Commerce Department reported that sales fell in the areas of furniture, clothing, and electronics and appliances. Building materials and garden equipment and supplies dealers experienced the largest sales decline since April 2012.

The chief economist for the National Association of Realtors (NAR) said “a powerful combination of lower mortgage rates, more inventory, rising income and higher consumer confidence is driving the sales rebound” as existing-home sales in February increased the most since December 2015. Including single-family homes, townhomes and condominiums and co-ops, existing-home sales came in at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 5.51 million reflecting a gain of 11.8% over the previous month. According to NAR, the price for existing-homes increased 3.6% in comparison to February 2018.

The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) said the final estimate for the fourth quarter gross domestic product (GDP) was 2.2%. This was in comparison to 3.4% GDP in the third quarter. The BEA said “the general picture of economic growth remains the same; personal consumption expenditures, state and local government spending, and nonresidential fixed investment were revised down; imports, which are a subtraction in the calculation of GDP, were also revised down.” The U.S. trade gap during 2018 jumped to a 10-year high of \$621 billion and the annual deficit in goods and services gained 12.5% or \$68.8 billion. According to Bloomberg News, the deficit increased “as tax cuts boosted domestic demand for imports while the strong dollar and retaliatory tariffs weighted on exports.”

Portfolio Commentary: Performance, Diversification, and Strategy

The Treasurer’s portfolio yielded 2.58% in March with a weighted average maturity of 874 days. The total assets under management by the treasurer was \$6.6 billion, in comparison to \$5.3 billion a year ago. The portfolio’s diversification strategy continues to be sound. U.S. government sponsored enterprises accounted for approximately 37% of the portfolio and mortgage-backed securities were 38%. U.S. treasuries represented 12% of assets, money market mutual funds were 9% and Certificates of Deposits were 3%. State bond issues, foreign bonds and municipals totaled 1% and comprised the balance of funds invested. In keeping with the state’s statutory investment objectives, the portfolio strategy continues to be seeking safety, liquidity, and return on investment, in that order. Laddered bond maturities and a buy-and-hold strategy were utilized. Market observation for investment opportunities were considered in order to maximize income within investment parameters and with regard to the likelihood of stable interest rates.

Collateralization

All funds under the control of this office requiring collateralization were secured at rates ranging from 102% to 110%, depending on the type of investment.

Payments, Fees, and Commissions

Securities were purchased or sold utilizing competitive bidding. Bank fees and money market mutual fund operating expenses are detailed in the attached pages, as is the earnings split between the treasurer and the master custodian bank on securities lending income.

Total Funds Invested

Funds available for investment, at market value, include the State Treasurer’s investments at \$3,921,193,663 and State Agency balances in OK Invest at \$2,693,198,084 for a total of \$6,614,391,747.











The following page presents market rates of return on the Securities portion of the General Account and the State's aggregated State Agency Accounts. These figures, which are dollar-weighted and time-weighted where appropriate, are calculated using the percentage change in market value (inclusive of accrued income) from the end of the prior month to the end of the reporting month.

To ensure the integrity of data, this information is provided by the Treasurer's custodian bank acting in its capacity as an external third party. As such, performance measurement is presently confined to those investments which are held with the custodian bank Northern Trust Company.



Note: Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62, Section 89.7, all known fees are to be reported. The money market mutual fund fees reported are shown at the contracted rate.

Securities Lending Program

The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Northern Trust Company acting as lending agent. Northern Trust retains 20% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the month was \$9,096. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains the first \$450,000 of security lending revenue in a revolving fund. These funds are used to pay custody and other banking fees. Any revenue not needed for this purpose is deposited to the General Fund.

Northern Trust Custody Fees

Pursuant to custodial contract with Northern Trust Company, custody fees are paid quarterly. Fees paid to Northern Trust Company for the three quarters was \$33,750.
