To the People of Oklahoma:

The Office of the State Treasurer is pleased to issue the May monthly investment performance report. I trust you will find it thorough, upholding my commitment to provide disclosure of the economic environment and portfolio results. As always, my staff and I are available to answer any questions.

Market Conditions

The treasury curve's shape was mostly unchanged in May and yields were slightly lower across much of the curve. The benchmark 10-year treasury yield closed the month at 1.60%, down 3 basis points from April's 1.63% close. The 2-year and 30-year treasuries were both down at 0.14% and 2.28%, respectively.

The equity markets were choppy, due to continued rising inflation fears. The S&P, Dow Jones and Nasdaq ended the month lower than in April, coming in at 0.55%, 1.93% and (1.53%), respectively. The returns for January through May were positive with the S&P coming in at 11.93%, the Dow up 12.82% and Nasdaq at 6.68%.

The minutes of the April Federal Reserve meeting were released. The New York Times said that "The Fed has kept its benchmark interest rate near zero since March 2020 and has been buying \$120 million in bonds each month, policies meant to keep many types of credit cheap and foster a stronger economic rebound from the pandemic recession. Officials have said they want to see "substantial" progress toward their goals, which are to hit 2 percent inflation on average over time and to foster maximum employment, before dialing back bond purchases. They want evidence that they have achieved those goals before they lift interest rates".

Economic Developments

Nonfarm payrolls in April were disappointing, coming in below expectations at 266,000. In addition, the previous month's nonfarm payroll of 916,000 was downwardly revised to 770,000. The unemployment rate rose by 0.1% to 6.1%, which was attributed to an escalating shortage of available workers. The only good news was that payroll numbers for February were upwardly revised by 68,000 to 536,000. CNBC reported that the "battered leisure and hospitality industry saw the biggest hiring gains, adding 331,000 workers though that still left the industry nearly 2.9 million shy of where it was before the pandemic".

The Labor Department reported that "the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased 4.2% over the 12-months from April 2020 - April 2021. The index rose 2.6% for the year ending March 2021. The 4.2% increase in April is the largest gain over a 12-month period since a 4.9% increase for the year ending September 2008. Over the longer period from January 2020 (before the COVD-19 pandemic) to April 2021, consumer prices increased 3.5%". Producer prices for final demand beat market expectations gaining 0.6%, in comparison to rising 1% in March. Trading Economics said that "About two-thirds of the increase are due to a 0.6% rise in services prices, namely portfolio management; airline passenger services; food retailing; fuels and lubricants retailing; and hardware, building materials, and supplies retailing".

Retail sales came in below expectations in April and were unchanged from the month before. There was an upward revision to March retail sales of 10.7%, from the previously reported 9.8%. On a year-over-year basis, retail sales jumped 51.2%. Reuters reported that a "2.9% rise in motor vehicles purchases was offset by declines in spending elsewhere. Sales at clothing stores tumbled 5.1%. There were also decreases in sales at sporting goods, hobby, musical instrument and bookstores. Sales at building material stores slipped 0.4%. Online retail

sales fell 0.6%". According to Trading Economics, "Retail sales are likely to rebound in coming months amid record saving and as the economy continues to recover and state and local governments further ease restrictions on businesses".

The sales of existing homes continued to slide with the seasonally adjusted annual rate for April of 5.85 million, in comparison to 6.01 million in March. On a year-over-year basis, existing home sales gained 33.9%. According to the chief economist for the National Association of Realtors, more homes will be up for sale later in the year as "further COVID-19 vaccinations are administered and potential homes sellers become more comfortable listing and showing their homes. The falling number of homeowners in mortgage forbearance will also bring about more inventory".

The gross domestic product (GDP) remained unchanged at 6.4% for the updated first quarter estimate of 2021. The Bureau of Economic Analysis reported the increase in real GDP "reflected increases in personal consumption expenditures, nonresidential fixed investment, federal government spending, residential fixed investment, federal government spending, residential fixed investment, and state and local government spending that were partly offset by decreases in private inventory investment and exports".

Portfolio Commentary: Performance, Diversification, and Strategy

The Treasurer's portfolio yielded 1.20% in May with a weighted average maturity of 827 days. The total assets under management by the treasurer was \$10 billion, in comparison to \$8 billion a year ago. The portfolio's diversification strategy continues to be sound. U.S. government sponsored enterprises accounted for approximately 41% of the portfolio and mortgage-backed securities were 29%. U.S. treasuries represented 23% of assets, money market mutual funds were 5% and Certificates of Deposits were 1%. State bond issues, foreign bonds and municipals totaled 1% and comprised the balance of funds invested. In keeping with the state's statutory investment objectives, the portfolio strategy continues to be seeking safety, liquidity, and return on investment, in that order. Laddered bond maturities and a buy-and-hold strategy were utilized. Market observation for investment opportunities were considered in order to maximize income within investment parameters and consideration of current low interest rates.

Collateralization

All funds under the control of this office requiring collateralization were secured at rates ranging from 100% to 110%, depending on the type of investment.

Payments, Fees, and Commissions

Securities were purchased or sold utilizing competitive bidding. Bank fees and money market mutual fund operating expenses are detailed in the attached pages, as is the earnings split between the treasurer and the master custodian bank on securities lending income.

Total Funds Invested

Funds available for investment, at market value, include the State Treasurer's investments at \$6,764,781,952 and State Agency balances in OK Invest at \$3,202,324,436 for a total of \$9,967,106,388.





In February 2021, the Treasurer estimated earnings to the Board of Equalization for Fiscal Year 2021. The amount estimated was \$46,500,000. Year-to-date actual earnings are recorded on a cash basis of accounting.

The following page presents market rates of return on the Securities portion of the General Account and the State's aggregated State Agency Accounts. These figures, which are dollar-weighted and time-weighted where appropriate, are calculated using the percentage change in market value (inclusive of accrued income) from the end of the prior month to the end of the reporting month.

To ensure the integrity of data, this information is provided by the Treasurer's custodian bank acting in its capacity as an external third party. As such, performance measurement is presently confined to those investments which are held with the custodian bank Northern Trust Company.



Securities Lending Program

The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Northern Trust Company acting as lending agent. Northern Trust retains 20% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the month was \$5,198. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains the first \$450,000 of security lending revenue in a revolving fund. These funds are used to pay custody and other banking fees. Any revenue not needed for this purpose is deposited to the General Fund.

Northern Trust Custody Fees

Pursuant to custodial contract with Northern Trust Company, custody fees are paid quarterly. Fees paid to Northern Trust Company for first three quarters was \$33,750.
