To the People of Oklahoma:

The Office of the State Treasurer is pleased to issue the December monthly investment performance report. I trust you will find it thorough, upholding my commitment to provide disclosure of the economic environment and portfolio results. As always, my staff and I are available to answer any questions.

Market Conditions

The treasury curve moved upward for the 2-year through 30-year offerings in December. The 10-year benchmark treasury came in at 1.51% which reflected a gain of 60 basis points from the end of 2020. The 2-year and 5-year treasuries were 61 and 90 basis points higher, respectively. The 30-year was 26 basis point higher, ending the year at 1.90%.

The stock indexes ended 2021 with a bang. The Dow Jones Newswire reported that "Even with the recent turbulence from the Omicron coronavirus variant, the S&P 500 saw a 27% advance for 2021 and has hit 70 highs. It is the third straight year of double-digit gains for the broad index, and the second amid the Covid-19 pandemic. The Dow Jones Industrial Average and the Nasdaq Composite have gained 19% and 21%, respectively, this year, helping send the major indexes to their best three-year performance since 1999."

The Federal Reserve kept interest rates steady in December, but due to continued high inflation they indicated they were prepared to raise interest rates at least three times in 2022. The Fed also said they would be accelerating the wind down in March of the monthly purchases of Treasuries and mortgage-backed securities. According to the Wall Street Journal, "Officials are giving more weight to the prospect that the aggressive fiscal-and monetary-policy responses to the pandemic last year altered traditional recessionary dynamics, buoying hiring and wage growth that normally takes longer to recover after a downturn."

Economic Developments

The non-farm jobs in November were disappointing at 210,000 and reflected the smallest monthly gain since last December. The Labor Department reported the October non-farm payroll number was revised upward to 546,000 from 531,000 and said that the unemployment rate dropped to 4.2% from 4.6%. The Wall Street Journal said "Fear of getting sick has been a persistent deterrent to the labor market's recovery. Faced with strong consumer demand, employers are clamoring for workers, raising pay, and sweetening bonuses and benefits."

The consumer price index (CPI) increased 6.8% year-over-year in November in comparison to 6.2% in the previous month. The gain was the largest 12-month increase since the period ending June 1982. Excluding food and energy, the CPI gained 4.9% on an annualized basis. The Bureau of Labor Statics said the energy index gained 33% over the last year, along with the food index increasing 6%. The increases in energy and food costs were the largest in 13 years. The producer price index (PPI) came in at 0.8% in November reflecting a gain of 0.2% from October. On an annualized basis, PPI jumped to 9.6% and was the largest increase since November 2010.

Retail sales in October were slightly revised upward from 1.7% to 1.8% and for November came in at 0.3%. The decline in retail sales, in comparison to the previous month, was attributed to consumers beginning their holiday shopping before Thanksgiving due to factors such as news of product shortages and creeping prices. Sales increased at grocery and liquor stores, gas stations, clothing retailers and home improvement stores. The New York Times reported that "Spending at electronics and appliances stores fell 4.6% last month, while sales at car dealers and

general merchandise stores, such as department stores, were down as well. Health and personal care stores, such as pharmacies, also saw a decrease of 0.6%."

Existing home sales gained 1.9% in November, compared to 0.8% for the previous month, and was the third month of a consecutive increase. According to the National Association of Realtors (NAR), "November's existing-home sales reached a 6.46 million seasonally adjusted annual rate. November's sales of existing homes declined 2.2% from November 2020, reflecting the off-season bump in sales in the second half of 2020 as the economy started opening up from the pandemic lockdown." In addition, NAR reported the average home price increased to \$353,900, up 13.9% from a year ago. There are concerns that continued rising home prices are keeping some buyers out of the market and first-time buyers dropped to 26% in November, which was the lowest level since January 2014.

The Labor Department reported the final estimate for the third quarter gross domestic product (GDP) was upwardly revised to 2.3% from 2.1%. The GDP for the second quarter was 6.7%. According to Trading Economics, "A resurgence of COVID-19 cases resulted in new restrictions and delays in the reopening of establishments in some parts of the country. In Q3, government assistance payments in the form of forgivable loans to businesses, grants to state and local governments, and social benefits to households all decreased. Looking ahead, analysts expect the US economy to expand at a faster pace in the current October-December quarter, putting it on track to record its best performance this year since 1984."

Portfolio Commentary: Performance, Diversification, and Strategy

The State Treasurer's portfolio yielded 0.99% in December with a weighted average maturity of 833 days. The total assets under management were \$11.1 billion, in comparison to \$9.2 billion a year ago. The portfolio's diversification strategy continues to be sound. U.S. government sponsored enterprises accounted for approximately 36% of the portfolio and mortgage-backed securities were 31%. U.S. treasuries represented 26% of assets, money market mutual funds were 5% and certificates of deposit were 1%. State bond issues, foreign bonds and municipals totaled 1% and comprised the balance of funds invested. In keeping with the state's statutory investment objectives, the portfolio strategy continues to seek safety, liquidity and return on investment, in that order. Laddered bond maturities and a buy-and-hold strategy were utilized. Market observation for investment opportunities were considered to maximize income within investment parameters and consideration of current low interest rates.

Collateralization

All funds under the control of this office requiring collateralization were secured at rates ranging from 100% to 110%, depending on the type of investment.

Payments, Fees, and Commissions

Securities were purchased or sold utilizing competitive bidding. Bank fees and money market mutual fund operating expenses are detailed in the attached pages, as is the earnings split between the State Treasurer and the master custodian bank on securities lending income.

Total Funds Invested

Funds available for investment, at market value, include the State Treasurer's investments at \$8,194,313,499 and State Agency balances in OK Invest at \$2,934,811,854 for a total of \$11,129,125,353.



Office of the State Treasurer Portfolio Composition December 31, 2021







Securities Lending Program

The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Northern Trust Company acting as lending agent. Northern Trust retains 20% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the month was \$12,652. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains the first \$450,000 of security lending revenue in a revolving fund. These funds are used to pay custody and other banking fees. Any revenue not needed for this purpose is deposited to the General Fund.

Northern Trust Custody Fees

Pursuant to custodial contract with Northern Trust Company, custody fees are paid quarterly. Fees paid to Northern Trust Company for the first two quarters total to 22,500.
