To the People of Oklahoma:

The Office of the State Treasurer is pleased to issue the March monthly investment performance report. I trust you will find it thorough, upholding my commitment to provide disclosure of the economic environment and portfolio results. As always, my staff and I are available to answer any questions.

Market Conditions

There were concerns the bond treasury yield curve would invert during the month, and the spread between the 5-year and 30-year was at 2.46% and 2.45%, respectively. A yield inversion had not occurred since March 2006. The 2-year and the benchmark 10-year treasury both were at 2.34%. A possible economic recession can be indicated if the 2-year yield is higher than the 10-year treasury yield.

The stock market rebounded in March with the S&P, Dow Jones and Nasdaq earning positive returns of 3.58%, 2.32% and 3.41%, respectively. The same indexes reflected losses in the previous month. On a year-to-date basis the S&P was down 4.95%, Dow at -4.57% and the Nasdaq came in at -9.11%.

At the March 16 Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) the benchmark federal-funds rate was increased by a quarter percentage point to a range between 0.25% and 0.50%, reflecting the first interest rate increase since 2018. The vote was not unanimous with James Bullard, the St. Louis Fed President, dissenting in favor of a larger half-percentage point increase. "Officials signaled they expect to lift the rate to nearly 2% by the end of this year-slightly higher than the level that prevailed before the pandemic hit the U.S. economy two years ago, when they slashed rates to near zero. Their median projections show the rate rising to around 2.75% by the end of 2023, which would be the highest since 2008," as reported by the Wall Street Journal.

Economic Developments

The economy added 678,000 jobs in February and the unemployment rate declined from 4.0% to 3.8%. According to Bloomberg News, "The labor force participating rate- the share of the population that is working or looking for work- ticked up to 62.3%, and the rate for workers ages 25-54 rose to the highest since March 2020. While improved, a combination of factors like childcare challenges, Covid-19 concerns and early retirements have whittled down America's workforce. Before the pandemic, the overall rate was over a percentage point higher."

The Labor Department's Bureau of Labor Statistics said the consumer price index (CPI) gained 7.9% on an annualized basis, reflecting a 40-year high. On a month-over-month basis the CPI increased 0.8% in February. CNBC said gas, groceries and shelter were the biggest contributors to the gain in CPI, but auto prices eased during the month. Core inflation, which excludes food and energy, rose by 6.4% which was the highest since 1982. The producer price index (PPI) increased to a seasonally adjusted 0.8%, lower than the previous month's 1.2% gain. The annualized PPI was up 10%, the highest since records began in 2010, and core PPI rose 0.2% for the month. According to the Wall Street Journal, "Higher energy and commodity prices have contributed to supplier-price increases. The energy component of the producer-price index leapt 8.2% in February from the prior month, compared with a median increase of 0.2% in the decade before the pandemic."

Retail sales for February slightly increased coming in at 0.3% and January sales data was upwardly revised to 4.9% from the previously reported 3.8%. January's sales surge was the largest gain in 10 months. The increase in prices for gas and food had a detrimental effect on consumers and was reflected in the decline in purchases of furniture, electronics, and appliances. According to Reuters, retail sales increased 17.6% from a year ago and

"excluding automobiles, gasoline, building materials and food services, retail sales fell 1.2% in February. Data for January was revised substantially up to show the so-called core retail sales rebounding 6.7% instead of 4.8%."

The supply of existing homes for sale continued to be a problem with inventory at 870,000 as of the end of February, with the unsold homes equal to 1.7 months of supply. The National Association of Realtors reported that existing-home sales dropped to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 6.02 million in comparison to 6.5 million in the previous month. Year-over-year sales declined 2.4% and the median home price jumped 15% from a year ago to \$357,300. Rising mortgage rates and continued home price increases are attributed to diminished housing affordability. The Wall Street Journal said "Rising borrowing costs pose another challenge for would-be homeowners already facing soaring home prices. An average rate around 4%, while still historically low, is sharply higher than the sub-3% rates that were available for much of last year. And the last time the 30-year mortgage rate topped 4%; the median home price was \$277,000- 26% lower than it is today."

The real gross domestic product (GDP) grew at an annualized 6.9% in the fourth quarter of 2021. This was in comparison to a previous GDP estimate of 7%. The Bureau of Economic Analysis reported the slight decrease primarily reflected "downward revisions to personal consumption expenditures and exports that were partly offset by an upward revision to private inventory investment."

Portfolio Commentary: Performance, Diversification, and Strategy

The State Treasurer's portfolio yielded 1.05% in March with a weighted average maturity of 1,016 days. The total assets under management were \$11.4 billion, in comparison to \$9.3 billion a year ago. The portfolio's diversification strategy continues to be sound. U.S. government sponsored enterprises accounted for approximately 33% of the portfolio and mortgage-backed securities were 30%. U.S. treasuries represented 31% of assets, money market mutual funds were 4% and certificates of deposit were 1%. State bond issues, foreign bonds and municipals totaled 1% and comprised the balance of funds invested. In keeping with the state's statutory investment objectives, the portfolio strategy continues to seek safety, liquidity and return on investment, in that order. Laddered bond maturities and a buy-and-hold strategy were utilized. Market observation for investment opportunities were considered to maximize income within investment parameters and consideration of current low interest rates.

Collateralization

All funds under the control of this office requiring collateralization were secured at rates ranging from 100% to 110%, depending on the type of investment.

Payments, Fees, and Commissions

Securities were purchased or sold utilizing competitive bidding. Bank fees and money market mutual fund operating expenses are detailed in the attached pages, as is the earnings split between the State Treasurer and the master custodian bank on securities lending income.

Total Funds Invested

Funds available for investment, at market value, include the State Treasurer's investments at \$8,441,799,825 and State Agency balances in OK Invest at \$3,030,348,762 for a total of \$11,472,148,587.



Office of the State Treasurer Portfolio Composition March 31, 2022





In February 2022, the Treasurer estimated earnings to the Board of Equalization for Fiscal Year 2022. The amount estimated was \$70,000,000. Year-to-date actual earnings are recorded on a cash basis of accounting.

The following page presents market rates of return on the Securities portion of the General Account and the State's aggregated State Agency Accounts. These figures, which are dollar-weighted and time-weighted where appropriate, are calculated using the percentage change in market value (inclusive of accrued income) from the end of the prior month to the end of the reporting month.

To ensure the integrity of data, this information is provided by the Treasurer's custodian bank acting in its capacity as an external third party. As such, performance measurement is presently confined to those investments which are held with the custodian bank Northern Trust Company.



Securities Lending Program

The State Treasurer participates in a securities lending program with Northern Trust Company acting as lending agent. Northern Trust retains 20% of the revenues generated as compensation for services, their share for the month was \$7,266. Pursuant to Oklahoma State Statute Title 62 Section 90, the State Treasurer retains the first \$450,000 of security lending revenue in a revolving fund. These funds are used to pay custody and other banking fees. Any revenue not needed for this purpose is deposited to the General Fund.

Northern Trust Custody Fees

Pursuant to custodial contract with Northern Trust Company, custody fees are paid quarterly. Fees paid to Northern Trust Company for the first three quarters total to 33,750.
