FLORAL REGULATION



- Fresh cut flowers may be placed on graves at any time but are recommended during the summer months. Plastic flower vases are provided in the brown receptacle containers labelled FLOWER VASES along the cemetery streets. The flower vases will be removed from the grave when the flowers become unsightly, and the vases will be replaced in the containers for reuse.
- Flowers will be removed from graves and disposed of by cemetery personnel when they
 become withered, faded or otherwise unsightly. During the mowing season, flowers
 will be removed twice monthly. During non-mowing season, they will be picked up
 monthly or as needed.
- 3. Artificial flowers will be permitted on graves during the period from November 1, through April 1. Potted plants will be permitted 10 days before Easter through 10 days after Easter Sunday. In observance of Memorial Day, all flowers will be permitted from the Thursday before the last Monday in May to the first Monday in June. Floral arrangements shall **NOT** be attached to the headstone.
- 4. During the Christmas season, Christmas wreaths, grave floral blankets and other such floral arrangements will be permitted commencing December 1 and allowed to remain on the grave through January 20 of each year.
- 5. Floral items and other types of decoration will **NOT** be secured to the headstones or niche covers.
- 6. Permanent plantings, statues, vigil lights, breakable objects of any kind and similar commemorative items are not permitted on graves at any time. These and other hazardous objects will be removed and disposed of by cemetery personnel whenever found on a grave.
- 7. Permanent flower containers are not authorized. The Government is not responsible for the safeguarding, maintenance, replacement or return of any container.
- 8. Please consult the Administrator for clarification of any regulation that is unclear to you.
