Claremore Veterans Home to Host Ceremony Honoring World War II Veterans on 80th Anniversary of the End of the War

CLAREMORE, OK – On Tuesday, September 2, 2025, at 2:45 p.m., the Claremore Veterans Home will host a special ceremony to honor nine World War II veterans on the 80th anniversary of the end of the war.

The event will include recognition of four residents of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) Veterans Home in Claremore, along with five additional World War II veterans from the community.

State Senator Seifried will present a Senate citation as well as a Governor's Proclamation in honor of the veterans' service. In addition, each of the nine veterans will receive a handcrafted challenge coin provided by Bison Coins.

"This is a historic occasion to pause and recognize the service and sacrifice of the men who helped secure victory in World War II," said Rob Arrington, ODVA Veterans Home Director. "Their contributions shaped the world we live in today, and we are proud to honor them here at Claremore Veterans Home."
