### **Memorial Bench Dedication to Honor Veterans in Oklahoma City**

**OKLAHOMA CITY, OK** — The Oklahoma City Chapters of the Sons of the American Revolution and the Daughters of the American Revolution have donated memorial benches to the **Oklahoma Veterans Cemetery (Union Soldiers Cemetery)**.

The cemetery is the resting place for Union soldiers from the Civil War and veterans from later conflicts, including World Wars I and II, the Korean War, and Vietnam. It sits at the southeast corner of NE 36th Street and Martin Luther King Boulevard.

These benches will be dedicated in recognition of veterans as part of the nation's 250th anniversary.

The event will take place on **Saturday, April 18, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.** at the **Oklahoma Veterans Cemetery (Union Soldiers Cemetery), 2312 NE 36th Street, Oklahoma City**.
