# Application for Special License Plates <br> For Law Enforcement 

## Read All Instructions Before Completing Application

1. Applicants for Police Officer License Plates require:

- a copy of your identification from the City or Municipality in which you retired or are currently employed as a reserve or full time officer.
- a copy of your identification from the University or Common Education Police Department within a School System in which you returned or are currently employed as a reserve or full-time officer AND Certification from the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET).

2. Applicants for a Deputy Sheriff License Plate require a copy of your identification from the Country Sheriff's Department which indicates you are a currently employed, a Retired County Sheriff or Deputy Sheriff, or a Reserve Officer.
3. Applicants for a Police Chaplain License Plate are required to show membership to the International Conference of Police Chaplains (ICPC).
4. Applicants for a Fraternal Order of Police License Plate require a copy of identification showing membership.
5. Once a special plate is issued and assigned to a vehicle, it shall be the only plate displayed on the vehicle. When a new plate is issued and assigned to a vehicle, all plates previously assigned to the vehicle will be ceased. All ceased plates should be disposed of or surrendered to a Licensed Operator or the Service Oklahoma.
6. When a new specialty plate is issued and assigned to a vehicle, the new plate will expire the same month as the previous plate.
7. Once a special license plate has been assigned to an applicant, the applicant shall have priority to such license plate for succeeding years, provided a timely paid application for renewal is submitted. To ensure receipt of a renewal application each year, notify Service Oklahoma of any change in your address.
8. Upon renewal of the special or personalized plate all renewal fees will be due for both primary and specialty registration. Penalties will apply.
9. Transfers of all plates, including specialty plates, from one vehicle to another vehicle, can only occur when titling a vehicle.
