Ex Prisoner of War License Plates may be issued to honorably discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification of that status. Such persons may apply for an Ex Prisoner of War License Plate for no more than two vehicles, with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for an Ex Prisoner of War License Plate for one vehicle with a rated capacity of one ton or less.
