

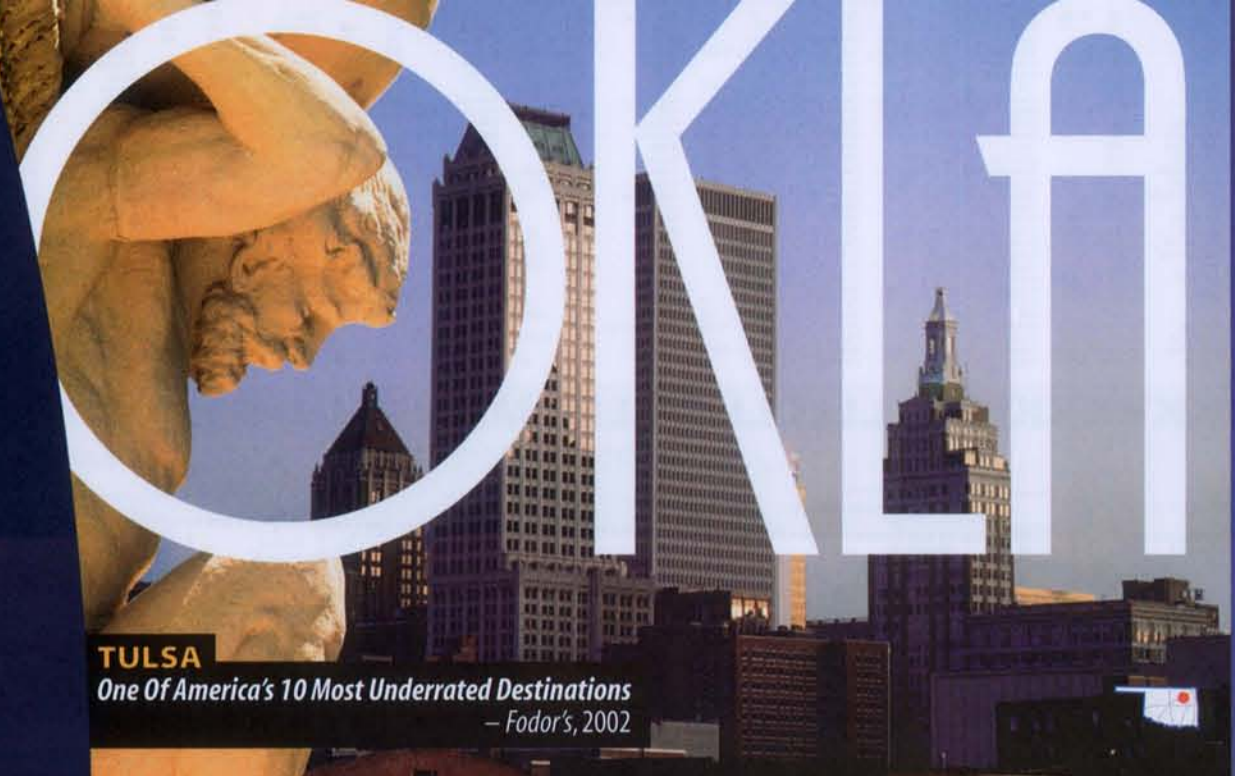

 OFFICIAL STATE MAP

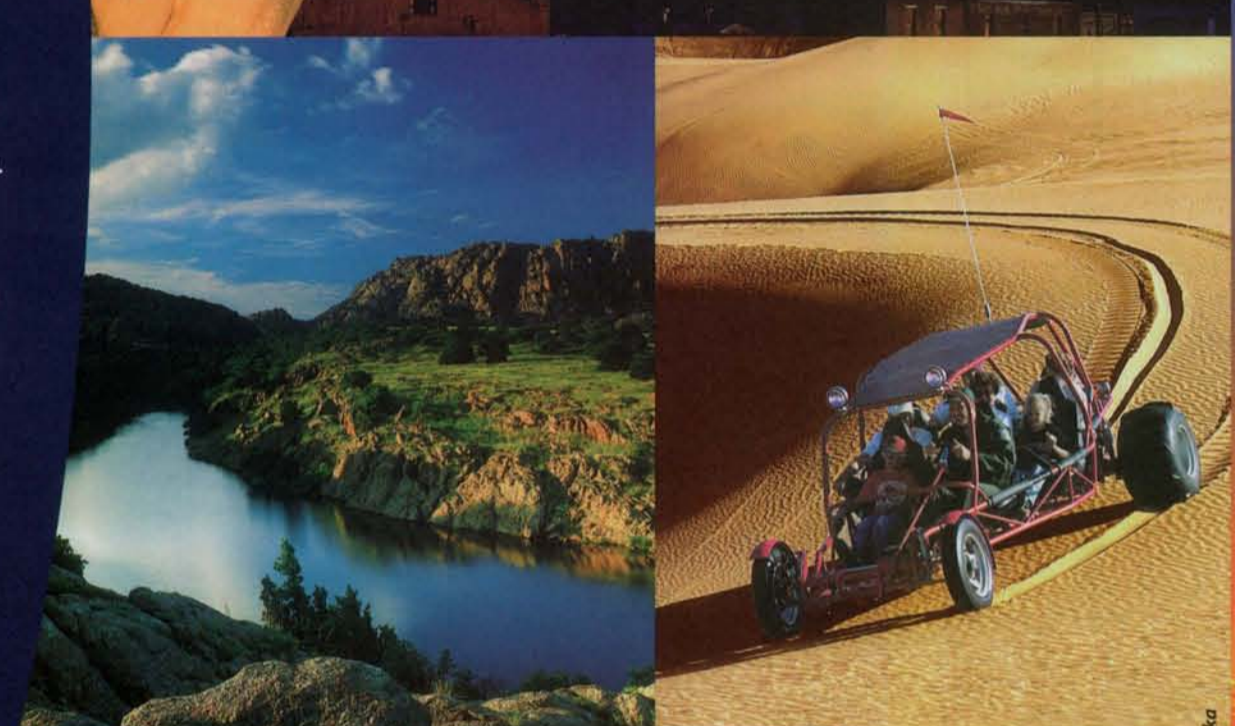
OKLAHOMA

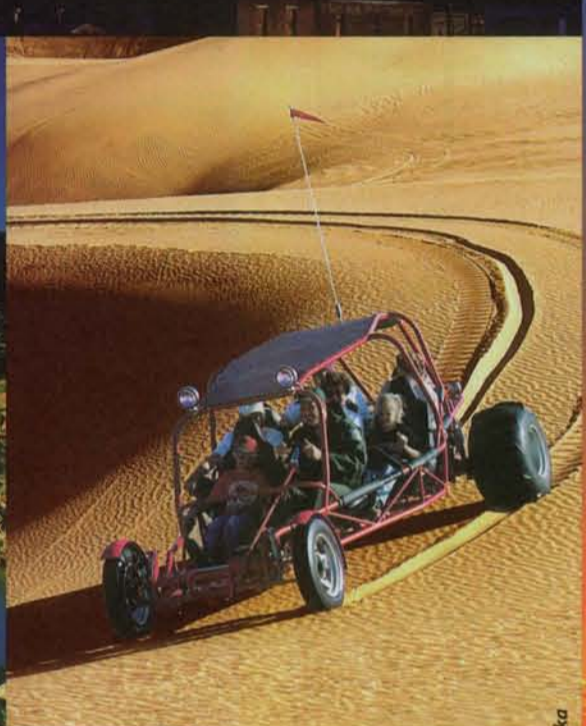

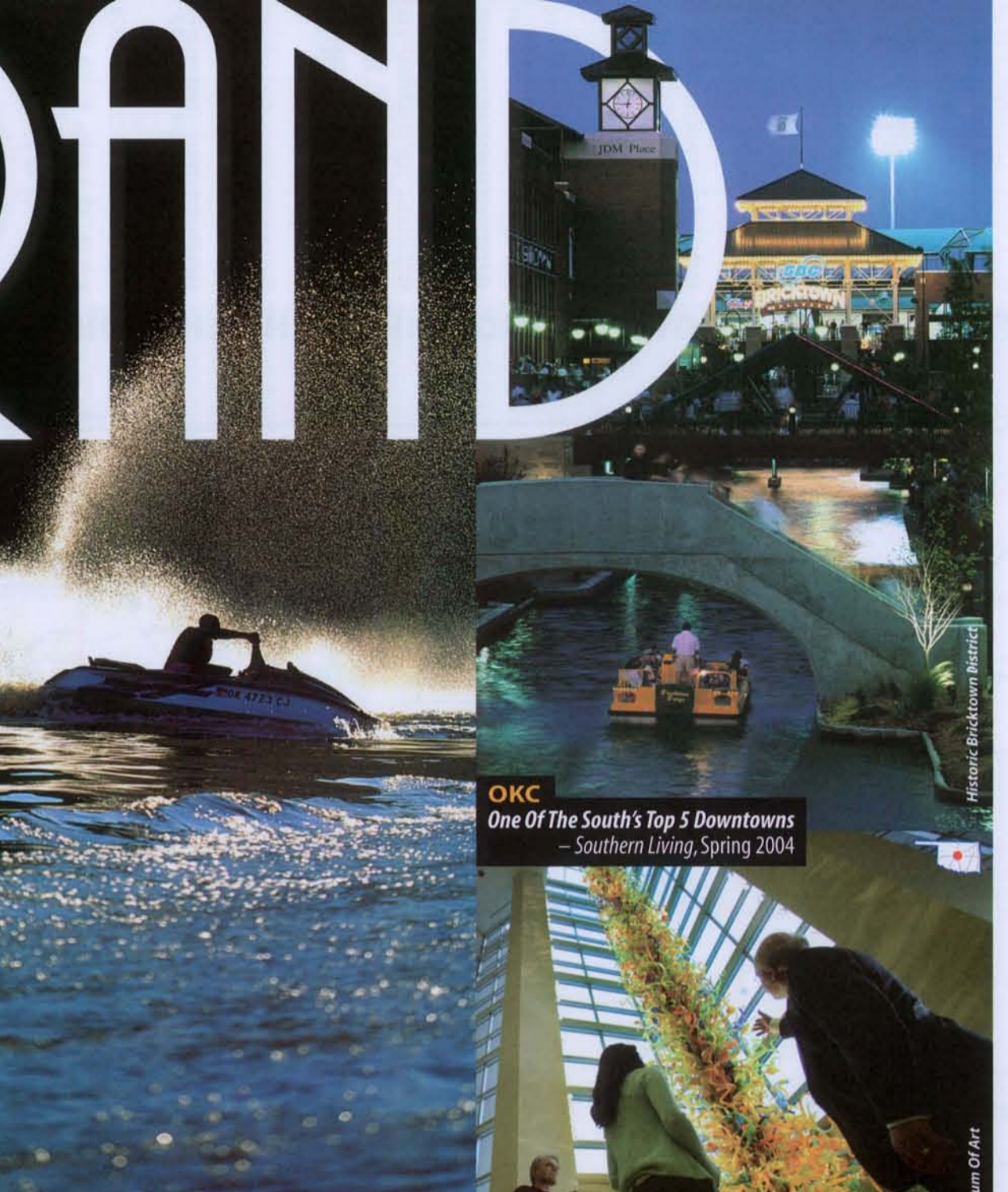

 The PIKEPASS saves time and money for the turnpike traveler. An electronic sensor in your vehicle records your passage and deducts the toll from a pre-paid account while driving 50-55 mph on Oklahoma's turnpikes.
