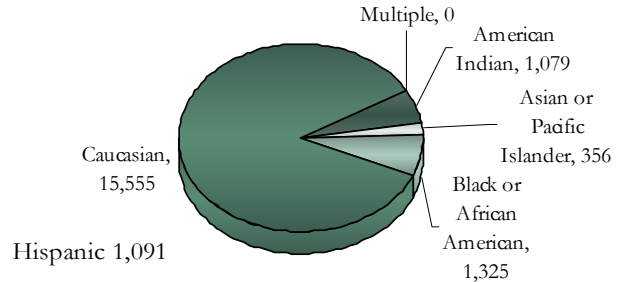

Race Breakdown of ESI Members



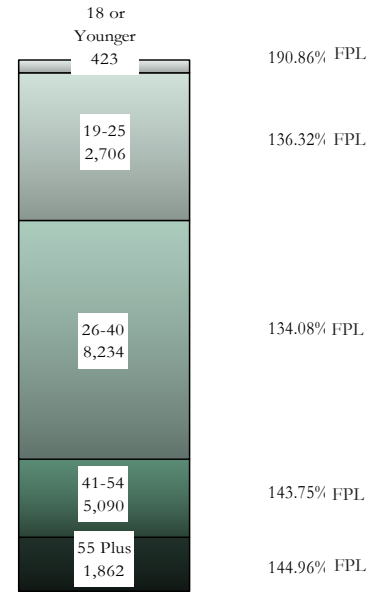

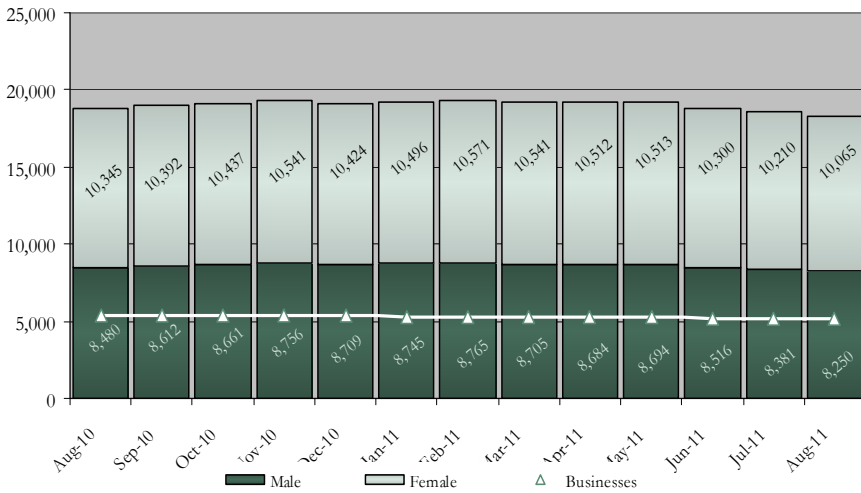

Age Breakdown with Average Federal Poverty Level of ESI Members

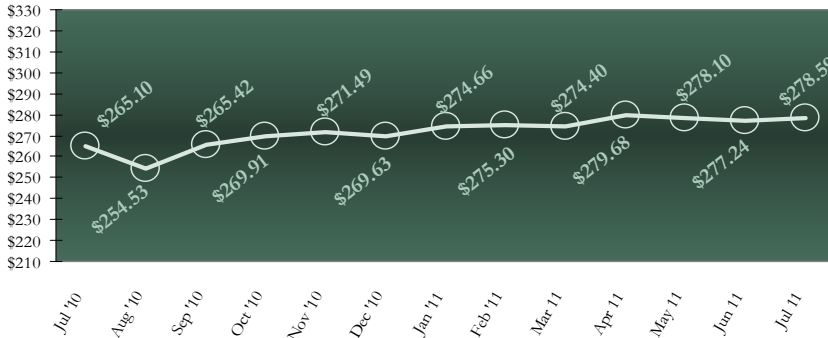

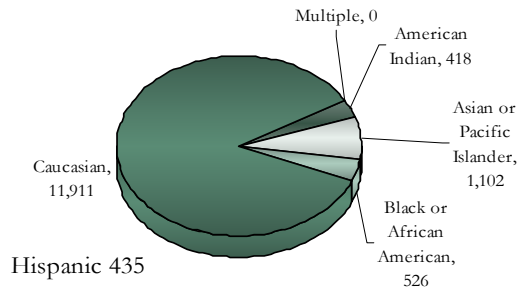
The Insure Oklahoma Individual Plan program is designed to provide Oklahoma individuals with health insurance for themselves and their dependents if eligible. It is available to Oklahomans who are not qualified for an employer-sponsored health plan and work for an Oklahoma small business with 99 or fewer full time employees; temporarily unemployed adults who are eligible to receive unemployment benefits through the Oklahoman Employment Security Commission; or working adults with a disability who work for any size employer and have a "ticket to work". 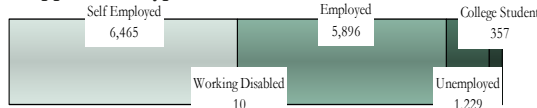

Race Breakdown of IP Members



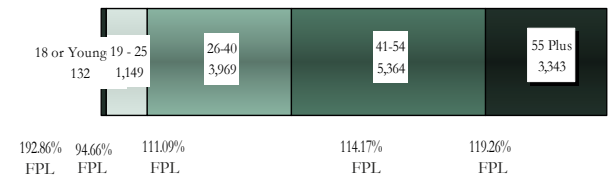

IP Age Breakdown with Average Federal Poverty Level for each group.

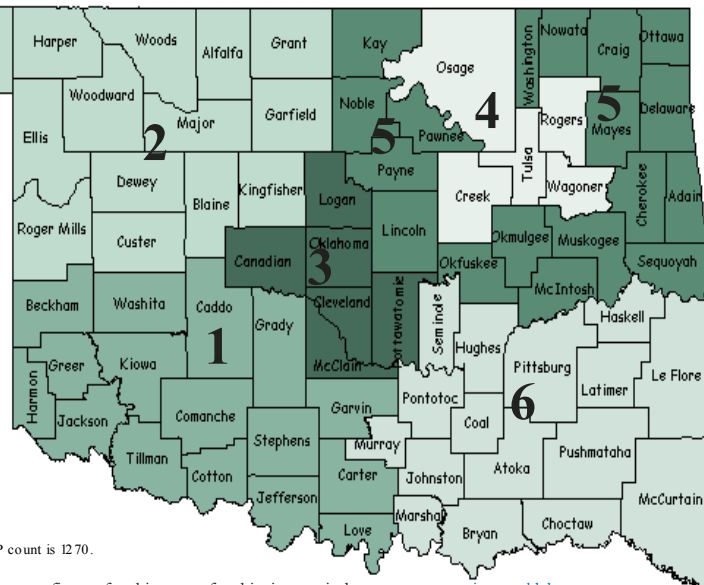
